### **NOTICE OF RACE (NOR)**

#### **1 RULES**

- 1.1** The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* and by US Sailing and the appropriate one-design class rules except as noted and changed by the Sailing Instructions.

#### **2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

- 2.1** The sailing instructions will be available no later than 1700 hrs on January 21, 2022, at Regatta Network website: <https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/23816> and at Sarasota Sailing Squadron (SSS) on the official notice board located by the race office.

#### **3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 3.1** The regatta is open to the following One-Design class classes: Flying Scot, Sunfish, M15, ILCA 7, ILCA 6, ILCA 4, E Scow, MC Scow
- 3.2** The regatta is open to PHRF boats holding a current valid WPHRF certificate to be scored. The PHRF classes will be Multihull and Monohull. It is the intent of the organizing authority to have two divisions of PHRF monohull racers based on entries received: one consisting of boats with ratings below 200 and another consisting of boats with ratings 200 and above for a course split for each division. Boats without a current valid WPHRF certificate may race in the Fun fleet and will not be scored.
- 3.3** A minimum of 3 boats required per class.
- 3.4** The organizing authority reserves the right to group similar boats together to form one or more classes.
- 3.5** To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.

#### **4 FEES AND REGISTRATION**

- 4.1** One-Design Boats may register for the event online at Regatta Network website: <https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/23816> or on January 22 at the Sarasota Sailing Squadron. Boat fee \$20
- 4.2** PHRF Boats must register for the event online through Regatta Network website: <https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/23816> Cut-off time for registration is January 21 at 1500 hrs. Boat fee \$30
- 4.3** Entry fee includes racing, awards, and dinner for crew: Food Truck serving Chattanooga Southern style chicken and keg beer under the Pavilion.
- 4.4** Extra dinner ticket for non-racers can be purchased online or at check-in desk day of regatta for \$20

#### **5 MEASUREMENT**

Each boat must be compliant with current class measurement rules.

- 5.1** Competitors in PHRF class who wish to be scored shall supply a current valid WPHRF rating to the organizing authority by January 21, 1500 hrs.

#### **6 COMMUNICATION**

- 6.1** The online official notice board is located at at: "Regatta Network "calendar": at

[www.regattanetwork.com](http://www.regattanetwork.com) and the physical official notice board is located at (SSS) board located by the race office.

- 6.2 [DP] When permitted by class rules, all boats shall carry a VHF radio capable or communicating on channel 72.
- 6.3 On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio. The channel will be stated in the Sis.
- 6.4 [DP] While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

- 9.1 One Design classes will include windward/leeward, triangles or any combinations of these. The specific course options and their designations will be diagrammed in the Sailing Instructions.
- 9.2 All other classes will sail a course which may include the following marks: Sarasota Sailing Squadron compass-rose marks, Sarasota Bay governments marks and/or inflatable marks.

## 10 SCORING

One race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta.

## 11 AWARDS

11.1 Awards will be given to boats placing first, second and third in each class

- 12.1 Competitors participate in the event entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race.
