SSC Mid Winters – Sailing Instructions

- 1) Setup time will be Friday and Saturday Morning
- 2) Radios will be tuned to Channel 69. If you have one, please keep it on your person or boat. The HSC works radio channel 13 and the USCG can be reached both there and 16
- 3) Boundries, The race course shall be placed in a box formed by the following. Any incursion into the shipping lane will be an immediate disqualification for that race.
 - a. The Bayport ship channel to the north
 - b. The Houston Ship channel to the east
 - c. A line from Eagle Point to Red Fish Island to the south.
- 4) The race course will consist of triangles, and other design with fixed marks in the bay as noted on the chart provided at the clubhouse.
 - a. Course options
 - i. Icicle course, 2 laps one clockwise one counter clockwise with Kemah1&2 acting as a gate mark
 - ii. Conundrum style utilizing a turn mark off SSC, the High range, House, and Kemah 2
 - iii. Icicle course, 1 and done
 - iv. A Red Fish Island run.
 - b. Start line will be a line drawn from the club flag pole to a ball buoy set off the club pier.
- 5) Scoring, Low points system will win entire regatta
 - a. Prizes, pay out per every 3 boats
- 6) Skippers meeting at 1000 on both days, start at noon.
