

2022 PHRF Shorthanded Series

NOTICE OF RACE

1. BACKGROUND

1.1. The Monterey Peninsula Yacht Club PHRF Shorthanded Series is new for the 2022 season. The format of this shorthanded series is one race per day on April 3, May 1 and June 18 in PHRF boats that are single or double handed crewed on a nearshore course around fixed buoys in the vicinity of the Monterey Peninsula. All PHRF Shorthanded Series registered boats will start and sail the same course each race day and be scored together, but for the purpose of awards will be split into A and B fleets at 124 PHRF rating.

2. **RULES**

2.1. The PHRF series will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. The regatta is open to boats owned by MPYC members.
- 3.2. Entries shall be made online, using the MPYC Regatta Network portal at <u>MPYC Race</u> <u>Registration Packet</u>

4. BOATS

4.1. The regatta will be sailed in boats with valid 2022 PHRF ratings issued by the Monterey Bay PHRF Committee.

5. SCHEDULE

5.1. The PHRF Spring & Fall Series schedule is published in the 2022 MPYC Race Calendar available at <u>www.MPYC.org</u>.

5.1.1. MPYC Shorthanded Series 1 is scheduled for April 3.

- 5.1.2. MPYC Shorthanded Series 2 is scheduled for May 1.
- 5.1.3. MPYC Shorthanded Series 3 is scheduled for June 18.

6. **FEES**

- 6.1. Entry fees are specified in the MPYC Regatta Network race registration portal.
- 6.2. Entry fees for the MPYC Shorthanded Series 1,2,3 is included in the All PHRF, Sunset and Specialty Races race registration fee or individually if registered for the Shorthanded Series only.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

7.1. The 2022 Monterey Peninsula Yacht Club Sailing Instructions will apply. Additional sailing instructions, if required will be published at <u>www.MPYC.org</u>.

8. COURSES

- 8.1. The courses are listed in the 2022 MPYC Course list available at <u>www.MPYC.org</u>, or as posted by the race committee on the MPYC Race Committee boat.
- 8.2. The starting area will be in the vicinity of the MPYC Race Committee Boat.

9. SCORING

9.1. Scoring of all MPYC races will be in accordance with the 2022 MPYC Sailing Instructions.

9.2. The PHRF Shorthanded series A and B fleet winners shall be awarded based on the total number of places scored during the three-race series with the split at 124 PHRF rating.

10. **PRIZES**

10.1. The Race Chairperson, in consultation with the Fleet Captains, will determine trophies for the PHRF Shorthanded Series. Generally, trophies are awarded for first, second and third place finishers in each class for each series; except for a class with less than 5 entries, which may be awarded trophies for only first or only first and second place finishers at the discretion of the Race Chairperson.

11. DISCLAIMER AND LIABILITY

11.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
