- 2.1 The regatta is open to all beach catamarans under 21 feet and under with a valid SCHRS rating (www.schrs.com/rating.php).
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the registration form at www.RegattaNetwork.com and by providing proof of insurance and signing of liability waiver during registration.
- 2.3 All vessels are required to carry a VHF and/or cell phone.

 - 3.2 Single-Handed fee is \$55.

5. Sailing Instructions

The sailing instructions will be available during registration.

6. Venue

The Regatta will be sailed from Sandy Hook Bay, New Jersey.

- 7. GPS/Radio Communications
- 13.1 Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.
- 13.2 GPS units are allowed.
- 8. The Course: Sandy Hook Bay starting line to New York Harbor and rounding The Statue of Liberty in either direction (care must be taken not to enter into the restricted zone around the statue) and return thru the finish line.
- *All sailors must stay clear of the security zone surrounding Earl Naval Pier and the Statue of Liberty. Any boat entering the zones will be disqualified. There are a line of white buoys marking the position. A large yellow buoy will be placed at the border of the Navy restricted zone.
- 9. Awards: Trophies will be awarded for 6 classes:
- Worrell Cup Line Honors
- Jackson Memorial Cup 1st single-handed (corrected)
- Manhattan YC Cup 1st corrected
- Founders Cup 1st SHBCC boat back (corrected)
- Wind Water and Wheels 1st for the largest class
- Little Miss Liberty Cup Verrazano Bridge Race
