Sailing Instructions

1 RULES

The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2 COMMUNICATIONS WITH COMPETITORS

- 2.1 Notices to competitors will be posted online at: <https://dryc.org/RACING> by 0900 race day.
- 2.2 On the water, the Race Committee (RC) may monitor and communicate via VHF channel 68

3 CLASS FLAGS, CHECK IN & SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 3.1 The series class splits were posted for race #1 and are posted under each race.
- 3.1 [DP] Boats from Marina del Rey shall check in (approx. 945-1055) with the Check-In boat, stationed just inside the detached breakwater. **DO NOT CHECK IN VIA VHF.**
- 3.2 [DP] **Boats coming from other harbors** shall check-in via VHF channel 71.
- 3.3 The scheduled time of the first warning signal is **1055**.
- 3.4 Multiple sounds will be made approximately one (1) minute before the first warning signal.

4 COURSES & MARKS

- 4.1 From the starting line, sail the course signaled by the RC (code flag A or B).

Course A - (36.5 nm) – Leave the El Segundo buoy (2ES) and the west end of Catalina Island to port. Proceed to **SI 5.1 THE FINISH**.

Course B - (29.2 nm) - Leave the El Segundo buoy (2ES) and the west end of Catalina Island to port. Proceed to **SI 5.3 THE FINISH**.

- 4.2 The starting line will be in the vicinity of H Mark, between an orange flag on the RC signal boat and an orange flag or mark in the water.

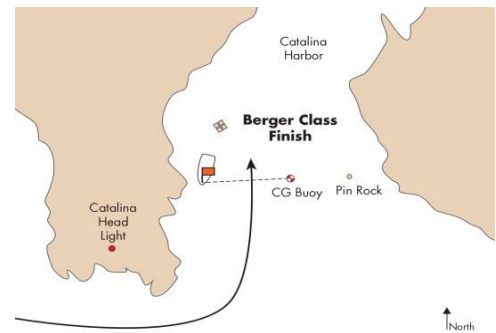
5 THE FINISH

5.1 Berger Division: The finishing line is between an orange flag on the RC boat to port and the Coast Guard mooring buoy (white with blue band) to starboard. Approximately 5 minutes before finishing, **AA boats only** shall hail the RC via VHF channel 68 to announce their sail number.

5.2 The RC intends to be **on station until 2000**. If absent, a mark (may be lit) will take her place. Complete the Race Report Form (RRF) Addendum Z when you cross the finishing line.

5.3 Stein Division: The finishing line begins at the Catalina Island west end light, extending 1/2nm to seaward. Complete the Race Report form (RRF) Addendum Z when the light bears 90° magnetic from your bow.

5.4 All Divisions: If applicable, the completed RRF shall be delivered to the finish board (near the galley at Schultz's landing) promptly after finishing or retiring. A photo of the form shall be emailed to racers@dryc.org, include your sail number and GPS finish time in the subject line.



6 TIME LIMIT

Boats not finishing by 2230 (Time Limit) will be scored DNF (this changes RRS 35 and A5.1).

7 HEARING REQUESTS

The protest time limit is 60 minutes after the protesting boat finishes or retires. Protests shall be emailed to racers@dryc.org, "Protest" shall be the subject line. Hearings will be scheduled for a later date.

8 SAFETY REGULATIONS

[DP] A boat that retires, shall promptly notify the RC at the first reasonable opportunity.

9 HOSPITALITY

9.1 Schultz's Landing has bathrooms, hot showers, ice and BBQs. The OA will provide water, sodas, beer and Margaritas. Coffee, OJ and bagels will be available Sunday morning.

9.2 Limited shuttle boat service to/from Schultz's Landing will be provided by DRYC volunteers Saturday night (last run 1145) and from approx. 0730 until 0930 Sunday morning. The drivers will attempt to monitor VHF channel 68. PLEASE LIMIT THE NUMBER OF TRIPS TO AND FROM YOUR BOAT BY COMBINING CREW ON EACH TRIP.
