AMENDED SUPPLEMENT to the STANDARD SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

4. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 4.2 The flagpole is located on the front lawn, easterly side, of the Sarasota Sailing Squadron.
- 4.3 When flag AP is displayed ashore, "1 minute" is replaced by "not less than 60 minutes" in the race signal AP.

5. SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 5.3 Number of races:

Day and Date	Maximum Races per day	First Warning Signal	Latest warning signal
Monday March 14	Discretion of Race Committee	11:30	
Tuesday March 15	Discretion of Race Committee	10:30	13:55

- 5.4 Additional races may be scheduled each day at the discretion of the principal race officer (PRO).

6. CLASS FLAGS

- 6.1 MC Scow Class Flag will be the MC class insignia, or such flag as will be displayed at the competitors meeting.

7. COURSES

- 7.3 Courses will be either LA, WA, or LAD. This supplement describes course LAD, the order in which the marks are to be passed and the side on which each mark is to be left.

8. MARKS

- 8.2

Mark	Description
1, 2s, 2p	ORANGE MarkSetbots
1a	YELLOW MarkSetBot
Start	Orange flag on boat and blue MarkSetBot
Finish	Blue flag on boat and blue MarkSetBot
Change Mark	Green inflatable

- 8.3 In the event of change of the windward mark, Mark 1a will not be relocated. Boats will round the new Mark 1 leaving it to port and shall disregard Mark 1a if it remains in the water.
- 8.4 If only one gate mark is set, boats shall leave the single mark to port.

12. TIME LIMITS

12.4

To Start	Mark 1 Time Limit	Race time Limit	Finish Window
4 minutes	15 minutes	60 minutes	15 minutes

- 12.5 A boat that does not start within 4 minutes after the starting signal will be scored Did Not Start, without a hearing. This changes RRS 5.1 and A5.2.

13. PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

- 13.5 Protest hearings are expected to be heard in person, but may be changed to online. Instructions for online hearings will be provided by the protest committee.

14. SAFETY

- 14.1 [DP] Boats shall check in with the race committee prior to their first race of the day. [DP]
- 14.2 [DP] A boat that retires from a race shall notify the race committee as soon as possible. [DP]

16. RADIO COMMUNICATION

- 16.1 The applicable VHF channel for this course is 72.
