1.0 Organizing Authority	The organizing authority is the Gulfport Yacht Club. This event is the third of four events of the 2022 Florida Weta Fleet Championship series.
2.0 Rules	 2.1 This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS 2021 - 2024). 2.2 This event is also governed by The North American Weta One Design Class Rules. The class standard and square top main sail are legal for this event. The self tacking jib is legal for this event.
3.0 Eligibility and Entry	3.1 This event is open to WETA class sailboats, both single handed and double handed divisions.3.2 This event is open to members of the WETA Class North America.
4.0 Registration and Fees	 4.1 Registration is by Regatta Network 4.2 Registration fees must be paid through Regatta Network. There will be no hand to hand transactions at this event. 4.3 Registration fee is \$80 per single handed boat and \$110 per double handed. 4.4 Registrations received after February 20 will be charged a \$25 late fee. 4.5 Online registration will close March 10 4.6 Regatta Fee includes refreshments and one dinner (two dinners for double handed entries). 4.7 Donations to TheMagicYarnProject.com, are separate, not included with registration fee.

12.0 Insurance	Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party
	liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$100,000 per
	incident or the equivalent. Proof of insurance will be required
	at registration.
13.0 Launching and Storage	All competing boats may be stored at GYC inside the club gates.
13.0 Laurierinig and Storage	Boats must launch from GYC beach. Provisions have been
	made with GYC to allow for storage of boats starting on
	Sunday, March 7 th . Non-member boats must be removed from
	GYC on Sunday, March 13 th .

14.0 Parking	Parking is available for trailers and cars outside the main entrance only. Vehicles parked blocking GYC members' boats, or interfering with access to the beach will be towed. Large transport trailers may be stored in the marina parking lot adjacent to the club.
