Notice of Race (NoR)

1. RULES

1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- **2.1** The sailing instructions will be available after 1700h on Thursday, March 17, 2022 at Sarasota Sailing Squadron and on-line at http://www.regattanetwork.com.
- **2.2** The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions (SSIs) that will be on the official notice board.

3 COMMUNICATION

- **3.1** The official notice board is located beside the race office at SSS. Race documents may also be found online at http://www.regattanetwork.com.
- **3.2** On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio. The channel will be stated in the sailing instructions (SIs). Such announcements are a courtesy and failure of the RC to make the announcement or of competitors to hear or understand the announcement shall not constitute a ground for redress. This changes RRS 62.1(a).
- **3.3** [DP] While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- **4.1** The event is open to all boats of the E- Scow, Viper, ILCA 6, ILCA 7, and Melges 14 classes.
- **4.2** Boats may only enter the event by registering online at Regatta Network "calendar" at https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/23940 Registration closes Monday, March 14, 2022.
- **4.3** To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.

5 FEES

- **5.1** Entry fees are as follows:
- 5.2 a) The fee for E Scow, and Viper will be \$175 per boat.
 - b) The fee for Melges 14 and Laser will be \$100 per boat.

the fees include continental breakfast and post racing socials, beer and other beverages and heavy hors d'oevres Friday, Saturday, and Sunday, and awards.

- 5.3 Registration received after March 3, will be accepted at an additional \$25 charge.
- 5.4 Thursday St. Patrick's Day Dinner Tickets are \$25 and will be available through March 9.

5.5 Tech short sleeve shirts are \$25 and will be available through March 3. No shirts will be available after March 3.

5.6 Entry fee refunds may be granted at the discretion of the of the OA. An administrative fee may be applied.

6 SCHEDULE

6.1 All classes will race a three-day event.

- **6.3** The RC may run one extra race on a day provided they do not get more than one race ahead of schedule.
- 6.4 On the last scheduled day of racing, no warning signal will be made after 1400 hrs.

7 VENUE

7.1 Racing will be in Sarasota Bay, either north or south of New Pass as specified in the Competitor briefing.

8 COURSES

8.1 Courses to be sailed will be windward/leeward or triangle/windward/leeward.

9 SCORING

- **9.1** One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- **9.2** Scoring for each class will be described in the Supplemental Sailing Instructions.

10 RISK STATEMENT

10.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury.

11 INSURANCE

11.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance. The organizing authority does not accept any responsibility for verifying that a boat has third-party liability insurance.

12 PRIZES

- **12.1** Prizes may awarded to boats placing first, second and third in each class with five or more entries; and to the first place in classes with fewer than five entries.
- 12.2 The winner of the Melges 14 class will be declared the 'Melges 14 Midwinter Champion'.

1. Parking
