## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1. RULES

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the current *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*.
- 1.2 RRS Appendix V, Alternative Penalties, Rule V1 will be in effect.
- 1.3 Participants agree to abide by the RRS and all other rules that govern this event and those of the host club. Payment of the Entry Fee acknowledges agreement and consent to this paragraph.

### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The event is open to the Flying Scot class only. FSSA membership is not required but is recommended.
- 2.2 Eligible competitors may enter the regatta by submitting an entry form and paying the fee online at Regatta Network.
- 2.3 No entries will be accepted after 1030 Saturday, May 14.

### 4. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

- 4.1 A maximum of 5 races are scheduled.

### 5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions with courses to be raced will be available at the Skipper's Meeting and a copy posted on the Official Race Notice board at the UKSC.

### 6. THE COURSE

- 6.1 The racing area will be just off the Upper Keys Sailing Club on Buttonwood Sound, Key Largo, Florida.
- 6.2 Courses will be windward-leeward to be described in the sailing instructions.

## **7. SCORING**

7.1 The Low Point Scoring System in RRS Appendix A will be used except that a boat's score shall be the sum of her finishes – no score will be excluded.

7.2 Five races are scheduled but completion of one race constitutes a Regatta.

## **8. PRIZES**

Awards for the top three competitors will be presented after the last race on Sunday, May 15, 2022.

## **9. BERTHING/PARKING/LAUNCHING**

9.1 Boats and trailers are to be kept in the area that will be designated for Flying Scot parking. It is suggested, but not mandatory, that boats be hauled at night.

9.2 There is a boat ramp and beach launching via vehicle towing available. There is no hoist.

9.3 Parking at UKSC is very limited. Unless launching, no vehicles are to be in the Flying Scot parking zone. Vehicles may park outside of the host club, being mindful of surrounding neighbors.

9.4 No overnight camping is permitted on the grounds of the UKSC.

## **10. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Sailing is an activity that has inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property, or injury, disease, or illness to any competitor, including death, which may be sustained in connection with, prior to, during, or after the regatta and all events associated with it. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
