Sailing Instructions

RULES

- 1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing
- 2. Any questions regarding these sailing instructions shall be submitted to the Sailing Office located the lower deck. Answers will be posted on the official notice board ASAP.
- 3. The Skippers Meeting will be at 11:30am the day of the race. It will be announced over the VHF Radio on channel 68.

CLASSES

- 1. PHRF Spinnaker, PHRF Non-Spinnaker, Multi-Hull, & Portsmouth will be sailed.
- 2. The Race Committee has the ultimate authority of what class a boat will be scored in.

SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 1. Signals made ashore will be displayed on the GYC flagpole located on the beach.
- 2. Flag "AP" with two sounds (one sound when lowered) means "The race is postponed. The warning signal for the next race will be made not less than forty-five (45) minutes after 'AP' is lowered." This changes Race Signals AP.

THE START

- 1. The starting area will be southwest of the Gulfport Small Craft Harbor.
- 2. The starting line will be between the orange flag on the Race Committee boat and an orange tetrahedron set to the North.
- 3. Boats shall not start before their assigned start time. (see Start Time Sheet)
- 4. All boats shall check-in with the Race Committee before the start.
- 5. Individual recalls will be signaled with an "X" Flag.

THE COURSE

- 1. After the start leave Broadwater Channel Marker #2 to port.
- 2. Leave Biloxi Channel #1 to port. N30.21.60 W88.54.20
- 3. Then honor all Biloxi Channel markers to the finish.
- 4. The course is 12 nautical miles. This cannot be protested.

THE FINISH

- 1. The finish will be between the orange finish flag located on top of the Biloxi Schooner Pier and adjacent Biloxi Channel Marker #22. N30.23.34 W88.52.22
- 2. All boats are asked to take their own finish time when crossing the line.
- 3. All boats must finish within 4.5 hours after its assigned starting time.

WITHDRAWING

A yacht which withdraws from the race or intends not to start shall inform the Race Committee or the Regatta Desk as soon as possible.

PROTESTS

- 1. All boats protesting during the race shall notify the competitor at time of incident, the race committee immediately upon finishing the race (or at the first reasonable opportunity).
- 2. The protesting yacht shall fly a protest flag off of the backstay if intending to protest. This changes the RRS.
- 3. Protests must be filled Race Committee within one hour of the protesting boat's finish time.
- 4. Hearings will be done in a "Three Minute Justice Format". Three judges will listen to each party for approximately one minute then, have a brief deliberation to decide outcome.

RESPONSIBLITY

- 1. It is each competitor's exclusive and individual responsibility to decide whether or not to race, continue racing, to wear life jackets when conditions warrant, and to otherwise provide for his crews safety.
- 2. All boats are required to carry all USCG required safety equipment.
- 3. Neither Gulfport Yacht Club nor its members accept responsibility for loss of life, injury to participants or others, or for loss or damage to any yacht participating in this regatta.

COMMINCATION

- 1. The race committee will monitor VHF Channel 68.
