NOTICE OF RACE

As amended to incorporate Amendment 1

RULES

- 1.1. Tred Avon Yacht Club (TAYC) is the Organizing Authority.
- 1.2. The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.3. All boats shall follow their respective class rules.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1. Sailing Instructions will be available on the event website approximately one week prior to race day and on race day in the clubhouse.

ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. The regatta is open to Penguin(Sat), Comet(Sat), Laser(Sun), Open 2.4mR's(Sat & Sun), and Albacores(Sat & Sun). More classes may be added. If you plan to race, please register early!
- 3.2. Eligible boats may register by going to the TAYC website (www.tayc.com/racing) and completing the entry form by 0800 on Saturday, April 30. **Online registration is required.**
- 3.3. Races may be cancelled for any class if less than three (3) boats have registered for such class by 1600 on Thursday, April 28.

FEES

- 4.1. The fee for Penguin, Comet, Laser, Albacore is \$35 for CBYRA or US Sailing, \$45 for non-members.
- 4.2. Entry for the Open 2.4m Class is \$90, including one dinner Saturday eve.
- 4.3. Entry fee to be received no later than 0800 on Saturday, April 30.
- 4.4. Additional dinner tickets for any class are available upon registration.

SCHEDULE

- 5.1. 4/29 - Friday arrival, rig and 2.4mR clinic. Ales and Tales 1800.
- 5.2. 4/30 - Saturday Continental breakfast. Penguin, Comet, Albacore, 2.4mR, 1st warning signal at 1100.
Post-Race Comet & Penguins Awards, hors d'oeuvres, BBQ Burger(See 4.4) and free keg.
- 5.3. 5/1 - Sunday Continental breakfast, Laser, Albacore & 2.4mR, 1st warning signal at 1030.
No race will start after 1500 on Sunday. 2.4mR, Laser, Albacore awards, hors d'oeuvres.

THE VENUE

- 6.1. Races will be sailed in the Tred Avon River using drop marks.

SCORING

- 7.1. A boat's regatta score shall be the total of all her race scores unless five or more races have been completed, in which case her worst score will be excluded, subject to Rule 90.3(b).
- 7.2. At least one race must be completed to constitute a regatta, 5(7-2.4m) races are planned.

PRIZES

- 8.1. Prizes will be given as follows: 1st if 3 boats register, 2nd if 5 register, 3rd if 7 or more register.

DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 9.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
