## **NOTICE OF RACE OPENING DAY RACE**

**February 19<sup>th</sup>, 2022**

**1. RULES:**

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the prescriptions of US SAILING, pertinent Class/Fleet Rules, the Waikiki Yacht Club Standing Sailing Instructions, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. The Racing rules will be changed as follows:
  - 1.2.1. Rule 52 is changed to allow the use of powered winches
  - 1.2.2. Racing rule 49 does not apply to Multihulls.
  - 1.2.3.6.4 Redress: RRS 60, 63.2, 63.4 US Sailing Prescriptions to RRS 60 (Participation Committee composition) are deleted.
  - 1.2.4. Rule 55 does not apply for spinnaker stopping materials only. It still applies to trash.

**2. ADVERTISING:** Advertising will not be restricted.

**3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 3.1. The regatta is open to all yachts. Eligible boats are required to register through regatta network. Please refer to:

**4. CLASSES:** Boats will be scored in Racing and Cruising Classes.

**5. FEES:** The entry fees will be \$20.00.

**7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** The Sailing Instructions will be available at the Skippers Meeting and on Regatta Network

**8. VENUE:** The waters off Waikiki.

**9. COURSES:**

- 9.1. Cruising Course-Start on the Ewa side between two inflatable marks near the Ala Wai Channel entrance, Counterclockwise rotation around Diamond Head Buoy, Clockwise rotation around Honolulu Harbor Buoy, Finish through the two inflatable marks near the Ala Wai Channel entrance.
- 9.2. Racing Course- Start on the Ewa side between two inflatable marks near the Ala Wai Channel entrance, Counterclockwise rotation around Diamond Head Buoy, Clockwise rotation around Keehi G1 Buoy, Finish through the two inflatable marks near the Ala Wai Channel entrance.

**10. SCORING:** RRS Appendix A2 is modified to allow no throw-outs.

**11. PRIZES:** Prizes will be presented for Racing and Cruising Classes at the awards ceremony
