

Addendum, 10/14/22

Notice of Race

Applies ONLY to FBYC Offshore Fall Invitational, 10/21 & 10/22

Event Description, Sec 1.1, Paragraph 3 is changed as follows:

Existing:

“The format for PHRF A, B, C, and NON-SPIN will be courses around drop marks. PHRF NON-SPIN will be sailed allowing only one (1) headsail downwind. PHRF CC (Cruising Class) will be sailed around government marks and drop marks”

Is Replaced with:

“On Saturday, 10/22, the format for PHRF A, B, and C, will be courses around drop marks. PHRF NON-SPIN and CC (Cruising Class) will be a mid-distance course sailed around government marks and drop marks.

On Sunday, 10/23, all classes (PHRF A, B, C, NON-SPIN, and CC) will be a mid-distance course sailed around government marks and drop marks.

For both days, PHRF NON-SPIN will be sailed allowing only one (1) headsail downwind.

For distance course descriptions, see the document ‘Fall Invitational 2022 – Distance Courses’ posted on the event site at Regatta Network”

Also,

Sec 4.1, Time Limit is changed as follows:

Existing:

“If one boat in a class finishes within five (5) hours of the actual start time of the race for that class, then the race will be valid for all boats in that class.”

Is Replaced with:

“The time limits for the first boat in each fleet to sail the course and finish are:

Saturday - 2 hours for PHRF Spinnaker classes and 3 hours for PHRF Cruising Class

Sunday - 3 hours for PHRF Spinnaker classes and 3 hours for PHRF Cruising Class

Boats still racing but not finished within the allowed time (30 minutes on a drop-mark course or 60 minutes on a distance course around government marks) after the first boat in their fleet sails the course and finishes will be scored Time Limit Expired (TLE) without a hearing and scored one (1) point more than the number of boats who sailed the course and finished within the time limit. This changes RRS 35, A4 and A5.”
