99th ANNUAL REGATTA

NOTICE OF RACE

The Edgartown Yacht Club 99th Annual Regatta (“the Regatta”) will be held in Edgartown, Massachusetts on July 8-10, 2022 for One-Design keelboats.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing for 2021-2024* (RRS), and the rules of the one-design classes in which a boat is competing as published in each class association’s web site.
- 1.2 RRS 40.1 is in effect. All sailors will be required to wear US Coast Guard approved personal flotation devices from the time they check in until they have finished racing.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available on the Official Notice Board no later than 1600 on Thursday, July 7, 2022.

3 COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 The Official Notice Board shall be on Regatta Network at www.regattanetwork.com.
- 3.2 All keelboats will be required to carry VHF radios capable of transmitting and receiving on Channels 16, 72, and 73.
- 3.3 On the water, the race committee may make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio. The channel will be stated in the SIs.
- 3.4 While racing, from the first warning signal until the end of the last race of the day, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The Regatta is open to One-Design Classes, including but not limited to Wianno Senior, Shields, J/70, Rhodes 19 (R19), Herreshoff 12 (H12).
- 4.2 Wianno Senior, Shields, J/70, R19, and H12 classes may register by completing the registration form and paying the required fee online at www.edgartownyc.org or www.regattanetwork.com on or before 1600, Friday, July 1, 2022. The Edgartown

Yacht Club may, at its sole discretion, accept any late entry. The deadline for late registrations is 1600, Thursday, July 7, 2022 for Shields; and 1600, Friday, July 8, 2022 for Wianno Senior, J/70, R19, and H12 classes.

4.3 A Representative from each Shields shall check in with the Race Committee Office in person or by telephone at (508) 627-4364, prior to 0900, Friday, July 8, 2022.

4.4 A Representative from each Wianno Senior, J/70, R19, and H12 shall check in with the Race Committee Office at (508) 627-4364, prior to 0900, Saturday, July 9, 2022.

5 FEES

5.1 The fee for all adult classes is \$100 per boat. This fee is waived for active adult members of Edgartown Yacht Club.

5.2 Full refunds, less the Regatta Network service fees, will be given for participants who withdraw at least one week prior to the start of their races. 50% refunds will be given for withdrawing prior to the day of their races. No refunds will be given for withdrawing after the scheduled start on the first day of racing.

6 ADVERTISING AND PHOTOGRAPHY

6.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

6.2 By participating in this regatta, each competitor grants to the organizing authority and its members, the regatta sponsors, and each class association the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, and to license any other person to so make, show and use, from time to time at their discretion, any photographs, sound recordings, motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television or other reproductions of them or their property made during the period of the regatta without compensation to such competitor.

8 EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

Boats may be inspected by a race official at any time for compliance with class rules.

9 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be windward/leeward.

10 VENUE

The keelboat classes will be sailed in Edgartown Outer Harbor for J70, R19 and H12 classes, and Edgartown Outer Harbor or Cow Bay for Shields and Wianno Senior classes.

11 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 11.1 For the Wianno Senior, Shields, R19 and H12 classes RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by a One-Turn Penalty.
- 11.2 For the H12 and R19 classes RRS 61.1(a)(2) is changed to require boats of these classes to display a red flag when intending to protest another boat.
- 11.3 The post race penalty option RRS V2 will be in effect.

12 SCORING

- 12.1 Two completed races are required to constitute a series for the R19, H12, Shields, and J/70 classes.
- 12.2 One completed race is required to constitute a series for the Wianno Senior class.
- 12.3 Scoring for all classes shall be as follows:
 - (a) When fewer than 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of its race scores. This changes RRS A2.1.
 - (b) When 6 or more races have been completed, its worst score will be excluded. An additional worst score will be excluded for every 6 additional races that are completed. This changes RRS A2.1.
- 12.4 A boat that competes in any races of the Regatta shall be scored for the entire series. A boat shall be scored Did Not Compete (DNC) or Did Not Start (DNS) for the races in which they did not start.
- 12.5 Boats still racing and failing to finish within 15 minutes after the first boat of their class sails the course and finishes will be scored Time Limit Expires (TLE) without a hearing and will be scored two points more than the number of boats that finished within

the time limit and not thereafter retiring or being disqualified. This changes RRS 35, A4, and A5.

12.6 RRS 90.3(e) regarding the correction of scoring errors will apply.

13 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

Keel boats shall not be hauled out during the Regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the Race Committee.

14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

14.1 As a condition of entry, each owner, skipper and individual participating crew member shall submit an online liability waiver release. The fully executed Liability Waiver Forms shall be submitted prior to racing. The waiver form link can be found on the regatta website at www.regattanetwork.com. Boats that start, but that have not completed approved liability waiver forms, shall be scored Disqualified (DSQ) without a hearing.

14.2 Scores given under 14.1 shall not be subject to redress.

14.3 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race, which states 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. **Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.** The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

15 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be adequately insured with current, valid third-party liability insurance that is appropriate taking into account the value of the boats racing and the type of racing.

16 PRIZES

16.1 Prizes will be awarded in each class as follows: A minimum of four competing boats in the class is necessary for a Second Place to be awarded. A minimum of five competing boats in the class is necessary for Third Place to be awarded. Additional prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the Race Committee.

16.2 The G. Richard Steigler Memorial Trophy will be awarded to the boat with the highest winning margin.
