2022 Carter Lake Open Regatta

1. EVENTS

The Carter Lake Sailing Club (CLSC) will conduct the 63rd Carter Lake Open Regatta at Carter Lake, Loveland CO. Saturday June 4 and Sunday, June 5, 2022. CLSC is the Organizing Authority.

2. RULES

This Regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined by the 2021-2024 *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) except as changed by this NOR, the Sailing Instructions, the rules & Regulations of Larimer County, and any and all guidelines, federal, state and county.

3. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions (SIs) will be available at on-site registration and at the competitor's meeting on Saturday June 4th. SIs may be posted on the CLSC website, <https://sailcarter.org/> on or before Friday June 3.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

4.1 The regatta is open to all self-righting (keel) boats. One design fleets with three (3) or more entries will be recognized as a class. Anticipated classes are at least two PHRF classes. Additional classes may be established at the discretion of the Race Committee. Classes may be formed into divisions for starting purposes & courses.

4.2 On Site registration will be available at the Carter Lake Sail Club Clubhouse Friday evening June 3rd and Saturday morning June 4th. Competitors who registered online at <https://sailcarter.org/> are required to check-in at the on-Site registration desk to pick up their Sailing Instructions and sign their waivers. Boats that have not registered and not paid their entry fee will not be considered competitors.

5. FEES

5.1 Early Registration is highly encouraged. Boats may register in advance by registering online at <https://sailcarter.org/>

5.2 Regatta entry fees are \$60 paid by May 6th, 2022, and \$75 after May 6th, 2022

Entry fees do not include park passes for vehicles or boats, available at the Marina or Park entry station

7. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to Competitors will be posted at the CLSC club house

8. PRIZES

Trophies will be awarded based on the number of competitors in each class:

Fleets with three boats will have a first-place trophy awarded

Fleets with four boats will have a first and second place trophy awarded.

Fleets with five or more boats will have a first, second and third place trophy awarded.

Additional prizes may be awarded at the organizing authority's discretion

9. VENUE

All races will be held on Carter Lake

10. SCORING

10.1 The Low Point Scoring System in the RRS Appendix A subject to modifications as defined in the Sailing Instructions.

10.2 The race committee will assign handicaps for boats entering the handicap (PHRF) class without S.A.I.L. PHRF certificates, not subject to appeal.

Competitors participate in this regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS Rule 4: Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.
