The following sections have been revised as follows:

3. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 3.1. The regatta is open to all sailors of the Tasar and Laser Masters classes.
- 3.2. To be eligible to sail in the **ILCA Masters PCCs**, competitors must have reached the age of 30 prior to the first day of the event **and must be current members of the International Laser Class Association**. Laser Masters will be assigned to age divisions as defined in the ILCA-North America Masters Guidelines.
- 3.3. **Laser Masters may enter with ILCA 6 or ILCA 7 rigs but may not change rigs during the regatta (Rig Swapping turned off). ILCA 6 and ILCA 7s will sail together and be scored together as a single fleet, except as noted in Section 12.2.**
- 3.4. Competitors may enter online by completing the registration form and paying all required fees on the [event website](#).
- 3.5. Competitors will be required to agree to a waiver of liability as a condition of eligibility. This waiver may be completed either during online registration or at the event check-in.

12. PRIZES

- 12.1. In the Tasar class, medals will be awarded to the top three finishers overall.
- 12.2. In the **ILCA Masters PCCs, the Don Trask Perpetual trophy will be awarded to the first ILCA 6 and first ILCA 7, and medals will be awarded** to the top finishers in each age division. The number of prizes will be adjusted to suit the number of competitors pre-registered in each division.
- 12.3. Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the organizing authority.
