#### 7. RACING AREA:

The race area will be the Eastern Bay (North of St. Michaels). If conditions dictate otherwise, the race area may be in Miles River. Race Area will be announced at the skippers meeting. Racing procedures will be conducted in accordance with Star Class rule, STCR 34.

#### 8. SCORING:

The low point scoring system of appendix A (RRS) will apply. Three completed races will constitute a series. Each boat's series ore shall be the total of her race scores unless five or more races are completed and then she may throw-out her worst race.

#### 9. TROPHIES:

Trophies will be awarded to the first, second, and third finishers. The District 2 Green Star will be awarded to the highest scoring District 2 novice.

The awards ceremony is scheduled at approximately 3:30 pm on Sunday following the last race.

#### 10. LAUNCHING AND BERTHING:

Hoist launching and dry storage in the Club field storage are included. Boat wash-down is only permitted at the wash-down area located in the Club field.
