#### **NOTICE OF RACE**

#### 1.0 GENERAL

- 1.1 Races will be run for PHRF Race and Cruise classes, Etchells and Rhodes 19s.
- 1.2 This race will be scored as part of the Wednesday Night Sunset Series for the PHRF and Rhodes 19 fleet. This race will NOT count for the Etchells.

#### 2.0 RULES

- 2.1 All races will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 2.2 There must be a Junior at the helm from the warning signal until the boat finishes. 2.2.1 Junior is defined as someone 21 years of age or younger.
- 2.3 All vessels must carry VHF radios

#### 3.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 The Sailing Instructions are available at the NBYC office and on the NBYC website.

#### 4.0 COMMUNICATIONS

- 4.1 The official Notice Board is located next to the Commodore's Parking space in the Race Committee bulletin board.
- 4.2 [DP] All boats shall carry a working VHF radio.
- 4.3 On the water, the race committee may make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on the VHF channel designated in the Sailing Instructions.
- 4.4 Emergency communication channels are VHF 16 for the Dartmouth HarborMaster, and NBYC Dockmaster monitors VHF channel 68

#### 5.0 ELIGIBILITY

- 5.1 Members and non-members are eligible to compete in Juniors at the Helm.
- 5.2 The event is open to all Etchells, Rhodes 19, PHRF Spinnaker and Non Spinnaker.
- 5.2 Handicap skippers must have a current PHRF-NE rating certificate.
- 5.3 Membership in US Sailing is strongly encouraged.

#### 6.0 ENTRIES

6.1 The entry fee is \$30 for NBYC members and \$40 for non-members. Competitors may enter by registering through Regatta Network on the NBYC website.

Members will be charged on their bills. Non-members can pay in the office.

Entries must be received by Wednesday, August 24, 2022 at 1700 hours.
