For the Ron Payne, if you are planning to practice on Saturday, high tide is at 9:44am. Low tide is at 3:55pm. Therefore, plan to arrive on Saturday at about 10:00-10:30 and rig in the street or in the elevated parking lot across from the Sailing Center (to the South). Our youth program's 50 Optis, Lasers and Nacra 15's will be out practicing by 11:00. We can then bring our boats into the Sailing Center and shove off the dock at Noon. It should take 45 minutes to get to where we can begin practice. If we practice for 2-1/2 hours to a max of 3 hours, that would have us finishing practice at 3:15 to 3:45 at the latest. Either way, we get back to the bridge at about slack tide or when the incoming tide will give us a push through the bridge. Coming back this late will insure that we arrive after the youth sailors and coaches are back in.

All must wear life jackets.

We are aware of two who plan to bring their boats on Friday afternoon. Please put your boats in the circular drive of the house to the left (West) of the Sailing Center, where you will see 4 or 5 Mercuries on trailers with their dark blue covers. Do not block the house's grass corridor to its back yard and the water.
