NOTICE OF RACE

The Neuse Yacht Racing Association is the Organizing Authority (OA) for The Cinco de Mayo Regatta. Blackbeard Sailing Club is the host venue.

1 RULES:

1.1 The event will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of USSailing, the various Class rules, and the rules of the NC Wildlife Commission and the US Coast Guard.

1.2 Penalties:

1.2 Section V1 of RRS Appendix V-Alternative Penalties applies. This changes Appendix V

1.3 Sections T2, T3, & T4 of RRS Appendix T – Arbitration applies. This changes Appendix T

1.4 If there is a conflict between the RRS and class rules, the class rules apply.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:

2.1 The event is open to one-design boats, including: San Juan 21's, spin. & non-spin; Ensigns; FJs: Wayfarer; Tanzer 16; 420s; Sunfish; etc.

2.2 Other one-designs may be accepted at the discretion of the OA. To constitute a class there must be at least 3 registrants. Fewer than 3 registrants will sail in an "Open" class and be scored under the Portsmouth Yardstick using DPN ratings.

2.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached registration form and submitting the required fee at [www.regattanetwork.com/event/T.B.A] by 2000 on Friday, April 22, 2022. Late entries may be accepted until 1800 on Thursday, April 28th only in already established classes or in the Open Class, and for an additional fee.

3 FEES:

3.1 The entry fee for all 2-person or more classes is \$25.00/ \$5.00 discount for US Sailing members and for NYRA members. Late fee of \$10.00 is added to entries submitted after 2000 on April 22nd.

3.2 Fiesta Tickets for the Mexican Buffet are \$15.00 each.

4 VENUE:

4.1 Race Headquarters and social events will be at BSC.

4.2 Racing will be on the Neuse River or Broad Creek.

5 SCHEDULE:

Saturday, April 30

1030: Competitors' meeting on the deck at BSC.

1155: First Signal for first class. More races to follow as conditions permit.

1730: Fiesta Shore Party at BSC

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

The sailing instructions will be available on or about 2000 on Monday, April 25th online at <https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/24297>, on the courtesy notice board on the front deck at BSC, and at the competitors' meeting.

7 COURSES:

The course(s) to be sailed will be defined in the sailing instructions.

8 SCORING:

8.1 Low point scoring as described in Appendix A of the RRS applies

8.2 One completed race is required to constitute the Regatta.

8.3 (A) If 5 or fewer races have been completed, a boats score will be the total of her race scores. This changes RRS A2

(B) If at least 6 races have been completed a boat's score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

9 PRIZES:

Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 boats in each 6-boat class; the top 2 if 5 or fewer.

10 LAUNCHING:

BSC offers 2 boat ramps as well as a beach area for dinghies.

11 INSURANCE, SAFETY & DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:

11.1 Each participating boat must be insured with a valid third-party liability policy.

11.2 Competitors participate in the race entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the race.

11.3 The safety of a boat and its crew is the sole and inescapable responsibility of the Skipper, who shall ensure that the boat is entirely sound, thoroughly seaworthy, and manned by an experienced and physically able crew. Neither the establishment of regulations nor inspection of a boat in any way limits or reduces the complete and unlimited responsibility of the Skipper.
