NOTICE OF RACE

As amended to incorporate Amendment 1

1. RULES

- 1.1 The Red Avon Yacht Club (TAYC) is the Organizing Authority.
- 1.2. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the rules of the International Star Class Racing Association (STCR).

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available on the event website by Monday, September 26.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1. The regatta is open to Star Class boats that comply with STCR 21 and 26.4.
- 4.2. Eligible boats are encouraged to register online by going to the TAYC website (www.tayc.com/racing) and completing the entry form for the event by 1500 Friday, September 30. All registrations must be completed online. If a Novice Skipper (as defined by STCR 23.7.1), please identify yourself on entry form.
- 4.3 A Competitor is not entered and will not receive a score until all fees are paid.

4. FEES

- 5.1. The entry fee is \$155 for US Sailing or CBYRA members, \$160 for non-members to be received no later than 1500 Friday, September 30. Entry fee includes continental breakfast on both days, Saturday buffet dinner and Sunday post-race hors d'oeuvres. More information on pricing for meals and other items will be posted on the event website as the race date approaches. Other food options are available for purchase at the time of registration.

5. SCHEDULE

6. MEASUREMENT

- 6.1. Boats and sails shall comply with all aspects of the ISCYRA rules.
- 6.2. Teams will not be held to STCR 31.1.3.

7. THE VENUE

- 7.1. Racing will be in the Tred Avon River or the Choptank River S/SW of the Choptank River Light, depending upon weather.

8. SCORING

- 8.1. RRS Appendix A4, Low Point System, will apply.
- 8.2. Three races must be completed to constitute the regatta.
- 8.3. If more than 4 races are completed, a boat's worst score will be excluded from her total score.

9. LAUNCHING

- 9.1. Boats may launch and haul at TAYC. Trailers must be stored in designated areas clear of the hoist and access lanes. No vehicles may drive on dock.
- 11.2. Once launched, boats may haul-out after Saturday's racing or remain in the water over night at TAYC's docks.

10. PRIZES

- 10.1. Prizes will be awarded as follows: 1, 2 and 3 overall for the weekend.
- 10.2. Special prizes may also be awarded:
 - AB Streeton Trophy: Winning boat after Saturday's racing.
 - North Emory Bartlett Trophy: Winning boat for Sunday's races.
 - Novice Skipper: Best overall score among novice skipper.
- 10.3. Prizes will be presented at the TAYC clubhouse following Sunday's racing. Results will be posted at www.tayc.com/racing.
