

Heritage Regatta / One-Design Classes August 27-28, 2022 Tred Avon Yacht Club Oxford, MD

NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. The Tred Avon Yacht Club (TAYC) is the Organizing Authority.
- 1.2. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.3. All boats shall follow their respective class rules.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1. The Sailing Instructions will be posted on the event website no later than 1700 August 22 and in the clubhouse on race days.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. The regatta is open to the following one-design classes: Shields, Star, Snipe, Penguin, and Comet.
- 3.2. Eligible boats may register by going to the TAYC website (www.tayc.com/racing) and completing the entry form for the event. Entry forms must be received no later than 0830 Saturday, August 27. On-line registration is required.
- 3.3. Races may be cancelled for any class listed above if less than three (3) boats have registered for such class by 1600 on Friday, August 26.
- 3.4. All regatta participants, including skippers and crew, must individually sign and electronically submit the TAYC Regatta Waiver and Release found at www.tayc.com/racing.

4. FEES

4.1. The entry fee is \$40 for CBYRA or US Sailing members, \$45 for non-members to be received no later than 0830 August 27.
