NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. The Tred Avon Yacht Club (TAYC) is the Organizing Authority.
- 1.2. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.3. All boats shall be in compliance with their respective class rules.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1. The Sailing Instructions will be posted on the event website no later than 1700 August 8 and in the clubhouse on race days.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. The regatta is open to all boats in the following one-design classes: Optimist (White, Blue, Red and Green), Jr 420, Jr Laser, Jr Laser Radial, Snipe, Penguin, Comet, Adult Laser, Adult Laser Radial, Albacore, Star and Shields.
- 3.2. Eligible boats may register by going to the TAYC website (www.tayc.com/racing) and completing the entry form for the event. For all Junior classes, please provide parent/guardian emergency contact information. For Jr 420 and Jr Lasers only, please indicate gender due to awards. Entry forms must be received no later than 0800 Saturday, August 13. On-line registration is required.
- 3.3. Races may be cancelled for any class listed above if less than three (3) boats have registered for such class by 1600 on Friday, August 12.
- 3.4. All regatta participants, including skippers and crew, must individually sign and electronically submit the TAYC Regatta Waiver and Release of Liability Form found at www.tayc.com/racing.

4. FEES

- 4.1. The entry fee is \$40 for CBYRA or US Sailing members, \$45 for non-members to be received no later than 0800 on Saturday, August 13.

- 6.1. Boats may launch and haul at TAYC. Store trailers in designated areas clear of hoist and access lanes.

7. THE VENUE

- 7.1. Courses will use drop marks on the Tred Avon and/or Choptank Rivers. Specific locations for each course will be described at Competitors' meetings.

8. PRIZES

- 8.1. Prizes will be given as follows: 1 if 3 entries, 2 if 5 entries, 3 if 7 or more entries.
- 8.2. Certain classes may award special trophies in addition to the above.
- 8.3. Prize winners will be recognized at the awards presentation at the Harleigh Presentation at 1630 on Sunday, August 15 (jacket and tie required). Tender service will be provided from the anchorage in Trippe Creek to Harleigh from 1600 to 1930.
