AMENDMENT #1 August 15, 2022

USSER 3.1.4 is amended to read:

Required: Each crewmember working the foredeck or the helm shall have a safety harness and compatible safety tether not more than 6'7" (2m) long with a minimum tensile strength of 4500 lb. (20kN). The tether shall have a snap hook at its far end and a means to quickly disconnect the tether at the chest end.

Strongly recommended: All crewmembers shall have a safety harness and compatible safety tether not more than 6'7" (2m) long with a minimum tensile strength of 4500 lb. (20kN). The tether shall have a snap hook at its far end and a means to quickly disconnect the tether at the chest end. (This will be required in 2023)"
