# **Notice of Race**

**Organizing Authority**: Hobie Fleet 106 and the Rehoboth Bay Sailing Association will be the organizing authority.

**Rules**: Racing shall be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US Sailing and the class rules of the International Hobie Class Association. Competitors are reminded that per IHCA class rule 26, at least one crew member per boat shall be a paid member of the Hobie Class Association. RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

**Eligibility and Entry**: This event is open to all class legal Hobie Wave's, Hobie Getaway's, Hobie 14's, Hobie 16's, Hobie 17's, Hobie 18's, Hobie 20's, Hobie Tiger and Hobie Wild Cat; Wave sails must be Hobie-branded.

**Venue:** Rehoboth Bay Sailing Association, Dewey Beach, DE. Sailing will take place on Rehoboth Bay. **Note:** Since this is an in season regatta, there are special rules to follow while at the club. See below for details.

Schedule:

Saturday Check in/Registration 8:00 to 9:30 AM Competitors meeting at 10am First race not before 11:00 AM

Sunday First race not before 10:00 AM

One race is required to be completed to constitute a series. When fewer than four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When four or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

The objective is 3-5 races per day. There is no maximum number of races scheduled.

**Sailing Instructions**: Sailing instructions will be posted in Regatta Network, on the official notice board and available Saturday morning.

#### **Radio communication**

In accordance with IHCA General Rule 16.3, competitors may use a VHF radio to monitor RC courtesy broadcasts. Its use and restrictions will be described in the Sailing Instructions. [DP]
