1 RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, 2021-2024.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 The regatta is open to all members in good standing of a GSBYRA Yacht Club, and /or US Sailing Association, and/or invited guest of BBYC.

2.2 Eligible boats may enter by registering online at www.regattanetwork/event/24442 by 1000 Saturday.
Unregistered boats will not be scored.

2.3 Classes are limited to PHRF Non Spinnaker, Marshall 18, One Design Handicap, C420, Flying Scot, Sunfish, and Laser.

2.4 Boats shall meet her class rules and all criteria upon which the 2022 GSBYRA Portsmouth or 2022 GSBYRA PHRF handicap is based.

5.3 A series of back-to-back-races are scheduled on each course for the day.

5.4 No warning signal shall be made after 1500.

6 SCORING

6.1 Five races are scheduled.

6.2 One race shall be completed to constitute a series.

6.3 When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores.

6.4 When five races have been completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

7.1 The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone. See RRS 3.

7.2 The organizing authority, Bellport Bay Yacht Club, and/or personnel conducting this event will not accept any liability for material damages or personal injury or death in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after this event.
