# Notice of Race

## 1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, except the US Sailing Prescription to Rule 63.2 will not apply.
- 1.2 International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea or government right-of-way rules shall replace Section 2 of RRS between sunset and sunrise.
- 1.3 US Sailing Nearshore Safety Equipment is required in addition to all required USCG boating requirements.
- 1.4 Under *World Sailing Test Rule DR21-01*, change the definition Start as follows:

**Start** A boat *starts* when her hull having been entirely on the pre-start side of the starting line, and having complied with rule 30.1 if it applies, any part of her hull crosses the starting line from the pre-start side to the course side either

- (a) at or after her starting signal, or
- (b) during the last 15 seconds before her starting signal.

When a boat *starts* in accordance with item (b) of the definition *Start*, she may return to the pre-start side of the line to comply with item (a) of the definition of *Start*, but, if she does not, she shall receive a Scoring Penalty calculated in accordance with RRS 44.3(c) (*20% scoring penalty for OCS*).

## 2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1. The sailing instructions will be available on the CC website NLT Thursday, May 26<sup>th</sup> at 18:00 hours.

## 3. COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 The online official notice board is located through the [SDCC](#) website.
- 3.2 On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on **VHF radio channel 68**.

#### 4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 This race is open to all racing boats greater than 20' LOA and designed and built to go offshore and who hold a valid rating certificate for the fleet in which they are entered (except for the Cruising Class).
- 4.2 Timely entries shall be submitted on-line [here](#). A link will also be located through the SDCC website.
- 4.3 **Entry Deadline is 1800 Wednesday, May 25, 2022.**
- 4.4 All entrants must include a copy of their rating certificate.
- 4.5 The Organizing Authority (OA) may cap entries as required due to limited Oceanside slip space. First entered, first racing.
- 4.6 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.

#### 5. CLASSES

- 5.1 PHRF Classes will be determined by the OA and will be the same for both races.
- 5.2 One Design classes with 4 or more entries before the entry deadline.
- 5.3 Cruising Classes, both spinnaker and non-spinnaker. Boats in the Cruising Class must have a PHRF RLC base rating greater than 45 and a Performance Factor less than 1.8. Ratings will be reviewed, and assigned, if necessary, by the Organizing Authority.
- 5.4 SWRF, Southwestern Racing Fleet.
- 5.5 SGYC Catalina class
- 5.6 MBYC Butler Handicap Fleet for those yachts not in section 5.1-5.4.
- 5.7 ORC Classes will be offered and determined by the OA. This class will be the same for both races.
- 5.8 [DP] The class numeral pennant must be flown from the backstay of all yachts, or in a prominent manner on the stern, when checking in, while racing, and when finishing. Competitors shall supply their own numeral pennant.
- 5.9 Official class assignments will be established and posted on the SDCC website no later than 1200 Thursday, **May 26, 2022**. Provisional assignments may be posted earlier.

#### 6. FEES

- 6.1 *Registration fees for The San Diego Pursuit to Mission Bay & Coastal Cup (which includes both the Butler Invitational and the OYC to SWYC races) are as follows:*

Up to 30 ft LOA	\$75
31 ft to 39 ft LOA	\$85
40 ft and longer	\$95

- 6.2 Registration includes slip fees in Oceanside Harbor for Saturday night. Food options for all weekend pre & post-race activities will be extra and details will be available on the SDCC website

#### 7. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

##### 7.1 RACING SCHEDULE

- 7.1.1 **Entry Deadline is 18:00 Wednesday, May 25, 2022.**
- 7.1.2 Friday, May 27, 2022 the first Warning signal on will be 12:55 hours for the first start.
- 7.1.3 Saturday, May 28, 2022 the first Warning signal on will be 11:40 hours for the first class.
- 7.1.4 Sunday May 29, 2022 The first Warning signal on will be 10:55 hours for the first class.

##### 7.2 SOCIAL EVENTS SCHEDULE

###### 7.2.1 Schedule Of Events At **Mission Bay Yacht Club**

- **Friday Evening May 27, 2022 - 6 pm to 10 pm.** MBYC will have food and beverage available for purchase, with live music. Shuttle service to/from Marnier's Cove will be provided by the Club for racers. Additional information will be available approximately one week prior to the race by email and at the CC event website.
- **Saturday Morning May 28** - MBYC will have breakfast available for purchase. Additional information will be available approximately one weekend prior to the race.

## 8. COURSES (*handicapping distances subject to confirmation*)

### 8.1 Friday, May 27: Fun Pursuit Race from San Diego to Mission Bay

- 8.1.1 Start at Buoy 17.
- 8.1.2 Leave San Diego Channel Buoy 3 to starboard
- 8.1.3 Finish inside the Mission Bay Jetty entrance.
- 8.1.4 **Handicap course length 12.5 nm**

### 8.2 Saturday, May 28: Butler Invitational

- 8.2.1 Start approximately ½ nm NW of Mission Bay entrance on a 300° bearing.
- 8.2.2 Leave Windward Mark to starboard, located approximately 1.0 nm directly upwind.
- 8.2.3 Finish approximately 500 yards directly west of the Oceanside Pier.
- 8.2.4 **Handicap course length 28.3 nm**

### 8.3 Sunday, May 29: Oceanside to San Diego Race

- 8.3.1 Start approximately 500 yards directly west of the Oceanside Pier.
- 8.3.2 **Course 1:** Finish just west of San Diego Channel Buoy 3,  
**Handicap course length 35.0 nm**
- 8.3.3 **Course 2:** Leave San Diego Channel Buoy SD to port, Finish near SD Buoy 5/6.
- 8.3.4 **Handicap course length 37.6 nm.**

## 9. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 9.1 The penalty for OCS is described in NOR 1.4.
- 9.2 USSA Prescription Appendix V - *Alternative Penalties*, shall apply.
- 9.3 USSA prescription Appendix T - Arbitration, shall apply.

## 10. SCORING

- 10.1 Two races are scheduled for the San Diego Coastal Cup.
- 10.2 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 10.3 A boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores.
- 10.4 Yachts without a local SD rating will have rating assigned by the OA
- 10.5 PHRF Classes shall be scored using PHRF San Diego Random Leg Course ratings.
- 10.6 Out of town yachts racing under SoCal PHRF Certificates shall use their area "G" rating. Yachts without Area G ratings will have one assigned by the OA.
- 10.8 SWRF will use their PHRF RLC ratings supplied by SWYC Racing Fleet.
- 10.9 MBYC Butler Handicap Fleet will use San Diego PHRF RLC ratings.
- 10.8 The Friday pursuit race to Mission Bay will not be scored in the CC total and those results will be presented at MBYC Friday night

**11. RISK STATEMENT**

- 11.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia, or other causes.
- 11.2 The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

**12. INSURANCE**

- 12.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with adequate valid third-party liability insurance

**13. AWARDS**

- 13.1 Take home Overall trophies will be awarded for each class based on points scoring as described in 6.1 and dependent on number of entrants..
- 13.2 The following perpetual trophy will be awarded for the Saturday race
  - 13.2.1 MBYC Butler Perpetual for first mono-hull (Corrected time)
  - 13.2.2 OA may add trophies as needed
- 13.3 The following perpetual trophies will also be awarded for the Sunday race.
  - 13.3.1 First PHRF Class Boat (Corrected Time)
  - 13.3.2 First SWYC PHRF Class Boat (Corrected Time)
  - 13.3.3 First OYC PHRF Boat (Corrected Time)
  - 13.3.4 First SWRF Boat (Corrected Time)
  - 13.3.5 Club Participation
  - 13.3.6 Mayor of San Diego (awarded to the 1st place boat corrected time)
  - 13.3.7 Mayor of Oceanside (awarded to the 1st boat to finish)
- 13.4 Tie scores will be determined by USSA RRS Appendix A
