1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (“RRS”) and ILCA Class rules, except as modified by the Sailing iInstructions.
- 1.2 All boats shall carry all Safety Gear as required by ILCA Rules. The PFD must be USCG approved and worn at all times while on the water except while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment.
- 1.3 The Sailing Instructions will be available online and during onsite registration.
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions shall govern. This changes RRS 63.7

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 ILCA 4, 6, and 7. Each class must have a minimum of 3 entries.
- 2.2 All entrants must be current members of ILCA North America.
- 2.3 Competitors shall enter by completing the entry form available on the event website and paying the required fees. Entry in the event is not final until registration is completed. All competitors must check in on site to complete registration.

3 FEES

- 3.1 Entry Fee: \$80.00 before August 15, 2022.
- 3.2 Competitors who have not paid the Entry Fee by midnight August 15, 2022. Will have to pay a \$10 late entry fee.
- 3.3 The entry fee includes Saturday night cookout and a regatta t-shirt.

5 SCORING

- 5.1 The low-point scoring system, RRS Appendix A will be used.
- 5.2 Low point scoring system, RRS Appendix A will apply modified so that each boats score will be a total of her raw scores, with her worst score discarded if five or more races are completed
- 5.3 One (1) race in a class shall constitute a regatta for that class. The number of races per day will be determined by the Race Committee. Racing will be on the Elizabeth River

6 VENUE

- 6.1 All regatta events will take place at Norfolk Yacht and Country Club, unless specified otherwise in the Sailing Instructions.
- 6.2 All racing will be in the vicinity or "R2"

7 SUPPORT BOATS

- 7.1 Coach/support boats must remain more than 50 yards from the course area except when asked to assist by the Race Committee.
- 7.2 All coach/support boats and support boats are required to monitor the course channel on a VHF radio and be ready to assist with safety when requested.

8 AWARDS

- 8.1 Prizes will be awarded to the top three boats in each class. Awards for top Masters divisions: Apprentice Master, Grand Master and Great Grand Master. Awards will also be presented to the top female in each fleet.

9 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 9.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4 Decision to Race. The Norfolk Yacht and Country Club, and organizers will not be liable for material damage, loss, death or personal injury in conjunction with the event.

10 FURTHER INFORMATION

- 10.1 Lodging and other information will be posted on the regatta website or social media. No camping is allowed on the club grounds.
