

Sunset Series 2022

<u>NOTICE OF RACE</u> Spring Series: May 3rd – May 17th – May 31st – June 14th Summer Series: July 19th – August 2nd – August 16th – August 30th

The Sausalito Yacht Club invites Bay Sailors to come out for the Sunset Series. Races are held on alternate Tuesday evenings in two four-race Series, designated Spring and Summer. Racing will take place in the Knox / Yellow Bluff area using courses optimized for conditions.

1. The Series will be governed by the rules as defined in the current edition of THE RACING RULES OF SAILING. Entry is open to all yachts with a current PHRF certificate or members of one-design fleets. Five or more one-design entries may constitute a class. Yachts without a PHRF Certificate may be assigned a rating at the discretion of the Race Committee.

2. Competitors may complete their entry online through the event website at one of the following links:

3. Entry fee for an individual series is \$80; for both Spring and Summer, \$140. Individual races are \$35. Entries for the Spring Series submitted after May 1st will be subject to an additional \$20 late entry fee, as will Entries for the Summer Series submitted after July 17th.

4. Scoring. RRS A5.3 applies. A minimum of one race shall be completed to constitute a series. For each series, if four races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score; otherwise, her score will be the total of her scores for the series; this changes RRS A2.1.

5. Sailing Instructions will be posted on the event website and available at the club no later than 1800 Monday, May 2nd.

6. The first warning signal for each race will be given at 1830.

7. Results will be posted to the club's race notice board after each race and on the appropriate event website the evening following the race. Or email:<u>race@sausalitoyachtclub.org</u>.

8. Trophies will be awarded to winners of individual races after each race. Series trophies will be awarded to series entries after the last race of each series. Single race entries are not eligible for Series trophies. At the conclusion of the Summer Series a perpetual trophy, The Lischeske Trophy, will be awarded. This goes jointly to the lowest scoring spinnaker and non-spinnaker competitors, from any class, across the two series.

[Not part of the Notice of Race] Racers are invited to return to the SYC for presentation of trophies, as well as no-host bar and food.
