## PRSA COVID-19 Guidelines

- The number one rule is safety. Please be considerate of others. We have a responsibility to fellow members as well as ourselves.
- Remember that PRSA does not own nor control the facilities at Washington Sailing Marina (WSM). We are asking all PRSA members to adhere to these guidelines when participating in PRSA events for the health and safety of our members and for the health and safety of all of those who use WSM facilities.
- Competitors and family/friends should have a mask available and follow posted restrictions when using the Marina facilities.
- As the status of, and guidance around, COVID-19 evolves, we will follow guidance from Alexandria, VA, VA, Washington D.C., and Maryland. Check these resources for updated transmission rates, and adhere to restrictions, around COVID-19:
