Notice of Race

Organizing Authority: South Beach Yacht Club

1. RULES:

1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

1.2 The current version of Development Rule DR22-01 Rule 18, the preamble to Section C, and Mark-Room shall apply. See Addendum X. (See link in “Other Information” at the end of the Notice of Race)

1.3 Rule 40.1 will apply at all times when boats are in the racing area and on their way to and from the racing area.

1.4 The sailing instructions may change additional racing rules.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 The regatta is open to members of the J/105 and J/88 Class Associations.

2.3 The entry fee is \$160, \$50 late fee applies after 1800 on June 11th.

2.4 Deadline for entry is 1700hrs on Friday June 17.

3. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

Saturday, June 18th, 1200hrs. First warning

Sunday, June 19th, 1200hrs First warning

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available no later than 2000hrs. Thursday, June 16th, on the event website.

5. RACING AREA and Courses

5.1 The intended racing area will be the waters of the south bay, east of Pier 40, San Francisco.

5.2 The courses will be defined in the Sailing Instructions using inflatable buoys.

6. SCORING: Eight (8) races are scheduled, of which one (1) must be completed to constitute a series. A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. This modifies RRS A2.

7. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY: Competitors shall participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk (see RRS 4, DECISION TO RACE). The organizing authority does not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.

9. PRIZES: Prizes will be awarded based on the number of boats entered. The trophy presentation will be held at the SBYC after completion of racing on Sunday.

Other Information

DOCKAGE: Guest berthing is available at South Beach Marina. There are 14 slips reserved and overflow space if necessary, most together on D and E dock. When you sign up on Regatta Network, there is a place for you to check if you need a slip. SBYC Regatta Chair will inform the Harbormaster of the Name and Type of your boat. A slip will be assigned, and the Regatta Chair will email you the number of your slip. To pay for your reserved slip, you can call the Harbormaster at 415-495-4911 using a credit or debit card and tell them it is for the J-Spot race and your assigned slip OR you can pay the Harbormaster in person any time prior to the race on Saturday. If there is a problem, please call the Regatta Chair at 415-971-1127.

The harbormaster will require the following information:

1. Boater name
2. LOA & Beam
3. DMV CF #
4. Insurance info

PARKING: Parking is available at the South Beach Marina Parking area. You will sign up for the parking spaces on the registration as well. One parking space will be included free for each boat that is staying in the Marina. Additional parking spaces can be obtained at \$10 each/ day. Fortunately, the Giants are not playing in town that night and parking should be ample.

HOSPITALITY: Coffee will be available on Saturday and Sunday mornings at 9:00. Food and bar service will be available from the menu on Saturday. In addition, there will be a taco bar on Sunday during the Awards Ceremony after the last race. Boats that do not have a space in the Marina can be rafted on the shoreline dock between C & D docks and D & E docks. When we know the number of boats coming to the awards ceremony, we will let you know the accommodations made for your boat.
