NOTICE OF RACE

1 Rules

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).

1.2 Racing Rule 40 is changed as follows: Replace the entire Rule with, "Competitors shall wear personal flotation devices, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. This rule applies at all times while afloat. Wet suits and dry suits are not personal flotation devices. Flag Y need not be displayed."

1.3 ILCA 7 and ILCA 6 rigs shall have separate starts and be scored separately.

1.4 The organizing authority is the Monterey Peninsula Yacht Club.

1.5 Practice sails like Intensity Sails are permitted in this event.

2 Eligibility and Entry

2.1 Competitors will be required to agree to a waiver of liability as a condition of eligibility. This waiver must be completed either during online registration or at the event check-in.

1.2 Proof of Covid-19 vaccination will be needed to enter the Yacht Club.

3 Risk

It is the competitor's decision to enter the regatta and to start or continue any race. The competitors are ultimately responsible for the risks. The competitor will accept full responsibility for all his/her actions during any activity related to the event. This includes on-shore activities before, during, and after the regatta.

6 Fees

6.1 Required Fees; The entry fee is \$40 and \$20 for juniors under 18 years of age.

6.2 Entries will not be accepted after 11 am on May 7, 2022.

7 Sailing Instructions

The sailing instructions will be available during on-site registration and online the day prior to the event.

8 Courses & Racing Area

8.1 Courses will be standard ILCA-NA courses as described in the ILCA-NA Masters Regatta Guidelines.

8.2 The racing area will be north of the MPYC yacht club about a half mile out to sea.

9 Scoring

9.1 The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A4, will be used except as modified below.

9.2 A minimum of 1 race must be completed to constitute a regatta.

9.3 When 6 or more races are completed a sailor may discard their worst score.
