Notice of Race
Wahine Sweetheart Regatta
May 14, 2022

1. RULES:

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the prescriptions of US SAILING, pertinent Class/Fleet Rules, the Hawaii Yacht Club Standing Sailing Instructions, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. The Racing rules will be changed as follows:
 - 1.2.1. Rule 52 is changed to allow the use of powered winches
 - 1.2.2. Rule 55 is changed to allow the use of banding for safety purposes
 - 1.2.3. Rule 63.2 and 63.4 do not apply.
- 1.3. Crew shall be at least 50% female (rounded up for odd number crews). More females are preferred but not required. Females are expected to have key roles. A wahine must be at the helm at all times from the preparatory signal of a race until the boat has finished the race. No male is allowed to touch the helm during this period. If a male must touch the helm during this time (for example in an emergency situation), the boat shall retire from that race. The skipper on record must be a member in good standing of any HYRA affiliated club in order to be eligible for the North Sails Wahine Skipper of the Year Trophy.

2. ADVERTISING: Advertising will not be restricted.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. This event is open to monohull keel boats of 21 feet or more.
- 3.2. Yachts will start and be scored together.
- 3.3. Eligible boats shall enter by registering on Regatta Network by the skippers meeting:

4. FEES: The entry fees will be \$40.00 for PHRF

5. SCHEDULE

- 5.1.** Regatta Network registration closes at the time of the skippers meeting
- 5.2.** Skippers' Meeting: 1030 Saturday May 14, 2022
- 5.3.** First Warning: 1225 Saturday May 14, 2022
- 5.4.** Number of Races: There will be a single race held on the waters of S. O'ahu.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: The Sailing Instructions will be available at the Skippers Meeting and on Regatta Network

7. VENUE: The Course Area will be off the south shore of Oahu

8. COURSES: The course will be displayed by the Race Committee at or prior to the warning of the race as described in the Sailing Instructions

9. SCORING: The scoring system is as follows:

- 9.1. All classes will be scored together

10. PRIZES: Prizes will be presented at the awards ceremony by the Wahine Series
