NOTICE of RACE

1. RULES

This series of races will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2021- 2024.

2. ELIGIBILITY

The series is open to all boats of the Optimist (Red, White, Blue and Green), C420, Laser and Sunfish classes.

3. ENTRY & FEES

3.1 Entry and Registration are on-line at <u>http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/24658</u>.

3.2 Entry Fee on or before May 25 is \$40.

3.3 Entry Fee is \$60 after May 25.

4. SAFETY

RRS 40 applies and all competitors shall wear a Coast Guard approved personal flotation device during all time on the water.

Abandoned race days will not be rescheduled. No Races will start after 4pm.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available in Race Documents on Regatta Network and will be posted with this NOR on the Regatta Notice Board inside the Club house before the first race of the series.

7. RACING AREA

The racing area will be on the waters south of the Club house in Bellport Bay.

8. SCORING

- 8.1 Sixteen races are scheduled and 4 races constitute a series.
- 8.2 To qualify to be scored for the series a boat in a class must be scored in a minimum of 50% of the races scored for the series. This changes RRS A2.1.
- 8.3 Each boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores with one worst score excluded if 6 races are completed, and two worst scores excluded if 12 or more races are completed.
- 8.4 For this series boats that are registered for this series but did not race any race of the series will not be scored for that race or races.
- 8.5 Boats that race in any race of the series but did not finish a race shall be scored one more place than the number of boats that finished that race. This changes RRS A2.1 & A2.2

9. AWARDS

Awards will be given for each class with a minimum of two boats of the same class for the series. There will be awards for each fleet of Optimist as well as an overall Optimist Winner.

10. BOAT STORAGE

Guest boats will be allowed to remain on the BBYC pad beginning May 29th until the end of the series and must be removed by 6/20.
