NOTICE OF RACE
Summer 2022 Club Races

1. RULES

1.1. The BRYC Summer 2018 Club Races will be governed by the 2021-2024 *Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*, the *prescriptions of the US Sailing Association*, and applicable Class regulations.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1. The series is open to all boats complying with the class regulations of the following classes:

- Wianno Senior
- Lasers
- Beetle Cat
- Catboats (open Class)
- Capri 14.2

2.2. The skipper of a Wianno Senior or a Beetle Cat, or a Capri, or a Laser shall be either a member of the Bass River Yacht Club or a member of [US Sailing](#). Other persons may steer the yacht briefly during spinnaker sets, repairs, or in similar situations.

2.3. Eligible boats may register and submit applicable required fees online to the Bass River Yacht Club via Regatta Network

2.4.1. Competitors must file a valid entry form, via Regatta.Net or by providing the form directly to the Race Committee prior to arrival at the start line, to be permitted to compete in the day's races. If a valid entry form has not been filed online prior to the commencement of the race, the competitor will be scored as DNC.

3. FEES

3.1. Required fees are as detailed in the entry form and payable via Regatta Network.

4. SCHEDULE

4.1. The BRYC Summer 2022 Racing Calendar will be available after 23 June 2022 in on the BRYC website.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. The sailing instructions will be available after 23 June 2022 in the racing area of the BRYC website.

6. VENUE

6.1. Unless advised otherwise by the Race Committee, in accordance with the Sailing Instructions, all races for Wianno Seniors and Catboats will be started within 1 NM of Bass River Bell Buoy No. 2.

6.2. Unless advised otherwise by the Race Committee, in accordance with the Sailing Instructions, all Beetle Cats will start within 0.5 NM of Bass River Buoy No. 4. Alternate starts may be conducted on Bass River at the discretion of the Race Committee.

7. THE COURSES

7.1. The courses to be sailed will be communicated as detailed in the Sailing Instructions and will normally be selected from those shown in Annex A.

7.2. For Wianno Seniors: course "W" is changed so that the number following the "W" specifies the total number of legs to be sailed, not the times around the course.

8. PENALTY SYSTEM

8.1. For the Wianno Senior class, rules 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe is required.

9. SCORING

9.1. Scoring will be the "Low Point" system of the RRS Annex A, except that no scores will be dropped.

9.2. Any yacht competing in more than one day of racing, but without payment of the entry fee, will subsequently be scored as DNC in any races after the first day of racing.

10. RADIO COMMUNICATION

10.1. While it is recommended that racers have a radio on board for communications, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones. A radio or mobile telephone of any type may be used, and is encouraged to be carried for use, in an emergency.

11. PRIZES

11.1. Prizes will be given as follows:

BEETLE CAT CLASS:

WEEKEND SERIES TROPHIES

A trophy is presented to the first and second place winners of both the July and August series races. Special races are not counted in the monthly point accumulations.

IRVING K. TAYLOR TROPHY, Special Race, July 4th.

ANDREW K. HENRY TROPHY, July Series, best overall.

BRYC CHALLENGE CUP, Special Race, Labor Day.

POPE LONG DISTANCE TROPHY, Long distance race.

RUTH LAWRENCE MEMORIAL SEAMANSHIP TROPHY, Special Race.

WIANNO SENIOR CLASS:

COMMODORE RICHARD E. LINCOLN TROPHY, Special Race.

MILLER BOWL CHALLENGE TROPHY, Special Race, Labor Day.

EDWIN L. FARRAR TROPHY Overall Series, Labor Day Weekend. In addition to the Labor Day race includes the weekend races of the Labor Day weekend.

TED FROTHINGHAM TROPHY, Second place in Labor Day Weekend Series.
