Eligibility: The AHYC Ms. Race is open to sailing yachts with a valid 2022 PHRF-MA rating certificate

and to yachts that race one design. Skipper and all crew must be female.

Pursuit start (boats start in order based on PHRF ratings – slower boats start Type of Race:

earlier than faster boats). Predetermined courses based on wind conditions.

There will be two PHRF divisions: Non-spinnaker and Spinnaker. The race must have at **Divisions:**

least 3 boats registered in a division to count.
