**Sailing Instructions.** Racing will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2021-2024*, except as modified and supplemented by the Biscayne Bay Yacht Racing Association Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions 2021-22, General Conditions and Sailing Instructions, Part II – Sailing Instructions: One Designs (available at [www.bbyra.net](http://www.bbyra.net)). No separate Sailing Instructions will be issued. Protests shall be delivered to the virtual Protest Desk within 1 hour after the race committee Signal Boat docks. The protest time limit and a list of protests received will be posted on the official notice board hosted on Regatta Network !#\$

Virtual hearings will be held as soon as practicable after racing. This changes BBYRA 15.1 and 15.2.

**Registration.** You are cordially invited to join us for the Coconut Grove Sailing Club's 2021 Annual One Design Regatta. **BBYRA registered One Design boats are already registered.** All non-BBYRA boats must register with Regatta Network, [https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/24800#\\_registration](https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/24800#_registration). The Registration deadline is 5:00 PM on Wednesday, October 19, 2022.

We are expecting entries in the Etchells, J24s/Sonars, Snipes, Flying Scots, Lasers, Finns and Sunfish classes. Flying Scots will also be sailing for the Sally Russell Trophy and the Charlie Fowler Trophy. Snipes will be sailing for the Gonzalo ÓOldManÓDíaz Trophy. Five races are scheduled with no more than four in a day, weather permitting (this changes BBYRA 8.2).

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION APPLICABLE TO ALL ONE DESIGN CLASSES**

- ¥ There is no entry fee for BBYRA OD, Flying Scot Series and Dinghy Series. Non-BBYRA boats \$60.
- On race day, each boat must check-in by sailing past the stern of the Race Committee boat on starboard tack prior to the warning signal of the first race in which it will be competing. No check-ins will be accepted during a starting sequence.
- CGSC parking is limited to Members only. Parking is available around the circle (metered) or at the Public Parking Garage next to the Sonesta for a discount with a CGSC stamp on your parking ticket. Class boats and trailers may be stored in the boat storage areas.
- Two electric hoists are available at CGSC. A public boat ramp is located adjacent to the Club property. One floating dock is available at the Club.
