1 RULES

1.1 The RRS will apply

1.2 Sailing instructions may be modified verbally on the water

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

1.1 Recognized classes will be **Sunfish**.

4 FEES

4.1 Entire Series: \$50.00.

5 QUALIFICATION

5.1 To be scored for series awards a boat must register for the entire series.

8 RACING AREA

Manasquan River between Route 35 Bridge and Point Pleasant Canal.

9 THE COURSES

Windward/Leeward/Triangular/Around the Buoys courses.

10 SCORING

10.1 The Low Point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply. RRS A.9, Race Scores in a Series Longer than a Regatta, replaces RRS A4.2.

10.2 The number of scheduled races is “multiple”, of which 1 must be completed to constitute the series.

10.3 A registered boat that does not come to the starting line will be scored DNC. DNC’S are excludable as provided below.

10.4 No race shall be declared official unless three or more entrants come to the starting line.

11 BERTHING

Boat Storage is available free of charge, to those intending at least 50% of the races. Skippers intending to store their boat at MRYC during the series should notify MRYC’s dockmaster at 732-528-6792 in advance of arriving.

12 RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

13 REQUIRED SAFETY EQUIPMENT

Notes: 1. All boats must carry a topline solely dedicated to towing and/or anchoring and readily available for use at all times. Line must be at least 24’ long and of sufficient strength to tow a swamped boat.

14 AWARDS

14.1 Awards will be presented at MRYC’s Awards Dinner.

14.2 The minimum number of awards for each class will be according to the number of contestants in each class as follows:

The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor’s participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.

16 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of the policy limit of their homeowner’s insurance policy per event or the equivalent thereof.
