# NOTICE of RACE ADDENDUM – A

#### CRUISING CLASS DEFINITION FOR THE PENINSULA CUP REGATTA

The Organizing Authority has created a Cruising Class to encourage participation by skippers of cruising type sailing vessels in the 30<sup>th</sup> Annual Peninsula Cup Regatta.

### **RULES**

#### 1. Vessels.

- 1.1. The vessel must be a keelboat with either a fixed keel or a keel centerboard.
- 1.2. Vessels must be painted with conventional bottom paint and wet sailed. No racing bottom paint such as VC-17 or other super low drag racing paints are permitted.
- 1.3 Competing vessels must have a PHRF rating prior to the first race.

#### 2. Mainsails

2.1. Mainsails must be constructed of woven Dacron.

#### 3. Headsails.

3.1. Large Roach headsails, such as Code Zero, drifters, "reachers" and spinnakers are not permitted.

## 4. Cruising Classes.

- 4.1. The Organizing Authority may, with notice to the registrant, change the class selection as follows.
  - 4.1.1. Cruising Class A with a vessel's LOA of 20ft to 26ft.
  - 4.1.2. Cruising Class B with a vessel's LOA greater than 27ft.
