CYC FALL SPORT/SMALL BOAT REGATTA

NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current version of *The Racing Rules of Sailing (2021-2024)*.
- 1.2 NAVAL and CRUISE SHIP PROTECTION ZONE: The Naval and Cruise Ship Protection Zone is a 500 yard regulated area of water surrounding all US Naval and Cruise Ship Vessels. All vessels within 500 yards of such vessel shall operate at the minimum speed necessary to maintain safe course and speed and shall proceed as directed by an official patrol. No vessel is allowed within 100 yards of Naval and Cruise Ship traffic
- 1.3 Sailboats sailing a similar course should take a conservative tactic to avoid any close quarter maneuvers to minimize collisions or prolonged entanglement.
- 1.4 All boats will carry an operational VHF radio (RC will listen and announce on Channel 67).

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Advertising is at the discretion of the Organizing Authority (Coronado Yacht Club).

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 Limited to fleets of 3 or more sport/small boats, skippers members in good standing of Yacht Clubs or Sailing Organizations recognized by US Sailing. Previous boats that have entered are: Beneteau 36.7; Moth; F18; Laser; 420; FJ; J70; J24; Hansa; Martin 16; Harbor 20.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by entering on Regatta Network:

- 3.4 All entries must be submitted by September 30 @ 1500 pm.
- 3.5 No Late entries will be accepted.

4 CLASSIFICATION

Classes will be explained in the Sailing Instructions once boats are registered.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 The sailing instructions will be posted on regatta network and available at the CYC Club Front Desk prior to September 30 @ 1500.

7 VENUE

7.1 There will be two venues for racing. There will be a Glorietta Bay course for the Hansa, Martin 16 fleet, and possibly a Harbor 20 fleet. The second venue for all other boats will be in the San Diego South Bay, with a starting area around buoy 30. This will be a Windward – Leeward race course.

8 THE COURSES

8.1 Course(s) will be outlined in the SI's.

9 RADIO COMMUNICATION

9.1 Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. CYC will be available on Channel 67.

10 PRIZES

10.1 Prizes will be given as follows:

Trophies will be handed out to the top three finishers of each class post racing (Sunday). Trophy party to have food.
