Notice of Race

1. Rules

- 1.1. The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2. RRS 40.1 applies while racing.

2. Sailing Instructions

- 2.1. The sailing instructions [Sis] will be available before 1100 hours on July 16, 2022, online through <https://scyc.org/regattas>

3. Communication

- 3.1. The official notice board will be located in the northeast window of the upper deck of the SCYC clubhouse.
- 3.2. Please bring your hand held VHF radios for race committee may make broadcasts to competitors.

4. Eligibility and Entry

- 4.1. This event is open to the Hobie 20, Hobie 18, Hobie 17, Hobie 16, Hobie Wave, Formula 18 Class, A Class Catamaran classes and Weta Class Multihulls.
- 4.2. At the sole discretion of the Organizing Authority, other Multihull one design classes under 21 feet may petition to participate if a minimum of three (3) boats are registered by the end of the normal registration period.
- 4.3. For each Hobie Class boat pursuant to IHCA Rule 26, One competitor must be a member of the IHCA
- 4.4. Eligible boats must enter by completing the online entry form and submitting it with the required fee at RN.
- 4.5. Competitors will be required to agree to a waiver of liability as a condition of eligibility. This waiver may be completed either during online RN registration or at the event check-in.

5. Fees

- 5.1. The entry fee before Thursday, July 14, 2022, is \$80 for double-handed boats and is \$70 for single-handed boats. Youth skippers under 18 and first time novice skippers can deduct \$20 from the entry fee. Entry fees are non-refundable
- 5.2. The Late entry fee is \$99 for double-handed boats and \$89 for single-handed boats for entries after the above date. Late fees may be waived at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.

6. Schedule

- 6.1. Competitor briefing is scheduled outdoors for Saturday July 16, 2022 at 1100 hours near the boat park at the SCYC hoist
- 6.2. The scheduled time of the first warning signal is 1255 hours each race day.
- 6.3. No races will be started after 1600 hours Sunday July 17, 2021
- 6.4. Up to nine (9) races are scheduled in the Regatta.
- 6.5. One (1) race will constitute a regatta
- 6.6. On Saturday July 16, 2022 after racing, an outdoor BBQ is planned. Details will be emailed to the competitors
- 6.7. Awards presentation is planned on Sunday, July 17, 2022 following racing. Details will be emailed to the competitors

7. Venue

- 7.1. Racing will be around temporary inflatable buoys in the north end of Monterey Bay. The racing area will be within a three-mile radius of the Walton Lighthouse on the Santa Cruz Small Craft Harbor west jetty.
- 7.2. Notice of Parking and Launching providing instructions regarding Launching, Trailer and boat parking, Vehicles and passes (Notice of Parking and Launching) will be posted on <https://scyc.org/regattas>
- 7.3. Competitors and guests will need to purchase parking and trailer passes to park and launch at Santa Cruz Harbor. Vehicles and Trailers not displaying a pass or not parked in the designated areas may be ticketed by the Santa Cruz Harbormaster.

8. Prizes

- 8.1. The number of prizes to be awarded will be at the discretion of the organizing authority and based on the number of normal registered competitors.

9. Risk, Disclaimer of Liability, & Personal Conduct

- 9.1. By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in an increased risk of injury. **Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.**
- 9.2. Competitors will accept full responsibility for all their actions during any activity related to this event. This includes on-shore activities before, during, and after the regatta.
