- 1. RULES: The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined by the Racing Rules of Sailing.

- 6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: Sailing Instructions will be provided at Registration. They may also be posted on the event site and at www.milesriveryc.org when available.
- 7. VENUE: The race area will be Long Haul Creek next to the Yacht Club and the adjacent Miles River. See next page for *PARKING* information.
- 8. SCORING: The low point scoring system of Appendix A (RRS) will apply. One completed race constitutes a series. Each boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores unless (4) four or more races are completed and then she may exclude her worst score.
- **9. LAUNCHING**: Hoist, beach, and ramp launching are available. Dry storage available in the Club field. Boat wash down/cleaning available in the Club field.
- 10. PRIZES: Awards will be given for 1st-3rd for C420, Laser Radial, and Opti White, Blue, and Red. In addition 1st 3rd will be awarded overall in the Opti fleet. Awards will be given to the top girl competitors in the Laser radial, Opti red, white, and blue, and the top all-girl C420 team. Participation awards will be given to all Green fleet sailors. The Organizing Authority may award additional prizes and/or give-aways.
