Notice of Race

Organizing Authority: Tahoe Yacht Club

1 RULES

- **1.1** This race will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Rule 40 will be changed as follows: Competitors shall wear personal floatation devices, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. Wet suits or dry suits are not personal floatation devices. Flag Y will not be displayed.
- 1.3 Rule 44.1 is changed as follows: A boat may take a One-Turn Penalty as described in rule 44.2 when she may have broken a rule of part 2 while racing.
- **1.4** U.S. Prescription to RRS 63.2 is deleted.

2 ADVERTISING

Advertising will be allowed subject to the World Sailing Regulation 20: http://www.sailing.org/tools/documents/Regulation20AdvertisingCode-[9882].pdf

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 In accordance with rule 75.1 boats must be entered by competitors who are members of appropriate sailing clubs. Those failing to comply are encouraged to join the Tahoe Yacht Club. Another alternative would be to join the Scuttlebutt Sailing Club at no charge:

- This series is open to any keelboat or multi-hull with an LOA of 18 feet or greater.
- Boats shall hold a current PHRF rating from the Lake Tahoe PHRF Committee.Eligible boats may be entered online not later than 1200 hours, 7/30/21:

- **3.5** While the race committee may start divisions separately, boats will be combined for scoring purposes.
 - Division 1 (PHRF < 37)
 - Division 2 (PHRF >36 and <119)
 - Division 3 (PHRF >118)

7 VENUE

7.1 The racing venue will be on the waters of Lake Tahoe, off the shores of Gar Woods Restaurant in Carnelian Bay.

8 SCORING

Races will be scored using the Tahoe PHRF Handicap System with Time-on-Time scoring as described by US Sailing: http://www.ussailing.org/competition/offshore/phrf

TCF = A/(B + PHRF)

Where A = 650

Where B will be assigned by the race committee:

B = 480 for heavy air, 550 for average conditions, 600 for very light air.

9 PRIZES

- **9.1** Prizes will be awarded based on entries.
- **9.2** Competitors are encouraged to attend the awards presentation at Gar Woods Restaurant shortly after the last boat finishes.

10 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The Tahoe Yacht Club and any other organizing authority for the regatta will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

Participating boats shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance. Boat owners are solely responsible to ensure that such coverage is current and adequate.
