NOTICE OF RACE

Organizing Authority: The organizing authority is the Baltimore County Sailing Center. Competitors and support persons will be required to comply with all current local, state and federal guidelines related to COVID-19 while on the host club grounds or participating in racing. This includes, but is not limited to, any venue-specific requirements promulgated by the Notice of Race (NOR), Sailing Instructions (SI) or any amendments thereto. The organizing authority may terminate the event at any time if they observe significant disregard for any local, state or federal guidelines, or venue-specific requirements.

Classes: Club 420, ILCA 6/Laser Radial, Optimist, W/B/R & Green. 420 and ILCA 6/Laser Radial competitors shall not reach their 19th birthday in 2022. Optimist sailors shall not reach their 16th birthday in 2022. Pinnies are recommended but not required.

Rules: The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing for 2021-2024, the prescriptions of US Sailing and the class rules of participating boats (except as any are changed by the sailing instructions).

Registration: On-line registration through Regatta Network is required. Registration closes at 0900 EDT on day of regatta. \$35 per sailor includes racing, awards ceremony and post-race snacks. After 1800 hours on Sunday, July 10, 2022, an additional \$10 late fee per sailor will be added. No refunds except for duplicate registrations or positive COVID test by registered sailor. No lunch is provided. Please bring a refillable water bottle. There will be water dispensers on hand to refill.

Awards: Trophies for 1st-3rd in 420, ILCA 6/Radial and Optimist Red, Blue and White fleets and Overall winner in Optimist fleet. Participation awards are presented to Green Fleet
