NOTICE OF RACE

The Port Townsend Sailing Association invites all Thistle, Flying Scot, Lightning, 505, 470, 420 and other small centerboard sailors to the 2022 Port Townsend Small Boat Regatta.

Rules: The series will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2021-2024, except as modified by Individual Class rules, the Sailing Instructions or the Appendices to the Sailing Instructions.

Eligibility: This regatta is open to Thistle Class sailboats, Flying Scot Class sailboats, Lightning Class sailboats, 505 Class Sailboats, 420 class sailboats, 470 class sailboats, and other small centerboard boats. Boats must conform to class crew, weight, rigging, and equipment rules.

Races: There will be a maximum of 9 races over the two days. One race will constitute a regatta. There will be separate starts for each class of boat.

Awards Ceremony for all classes on the lawn near boat ramp ASAP after conclusion of racing. Any leftover beer will be consumed at that time.

Scoring: Scoring will be in accordance with RRS Appendix A, Low Point Scoring System. No score will be excluded.

Prizes: Trophies will be awarded to the top 3 boats and crews in each class.

Launching & Boat Storage: Launching will be available at the Port Townsend Boat Haven Marina. Please note the marina is paid a separate launch fee by boat owners. Boats may be stored overnight at the marina in designated spaces.

The Port will provide a place to park boats overnight on both Friday and Saturday. Further information regarding that parking will be forthcoming.

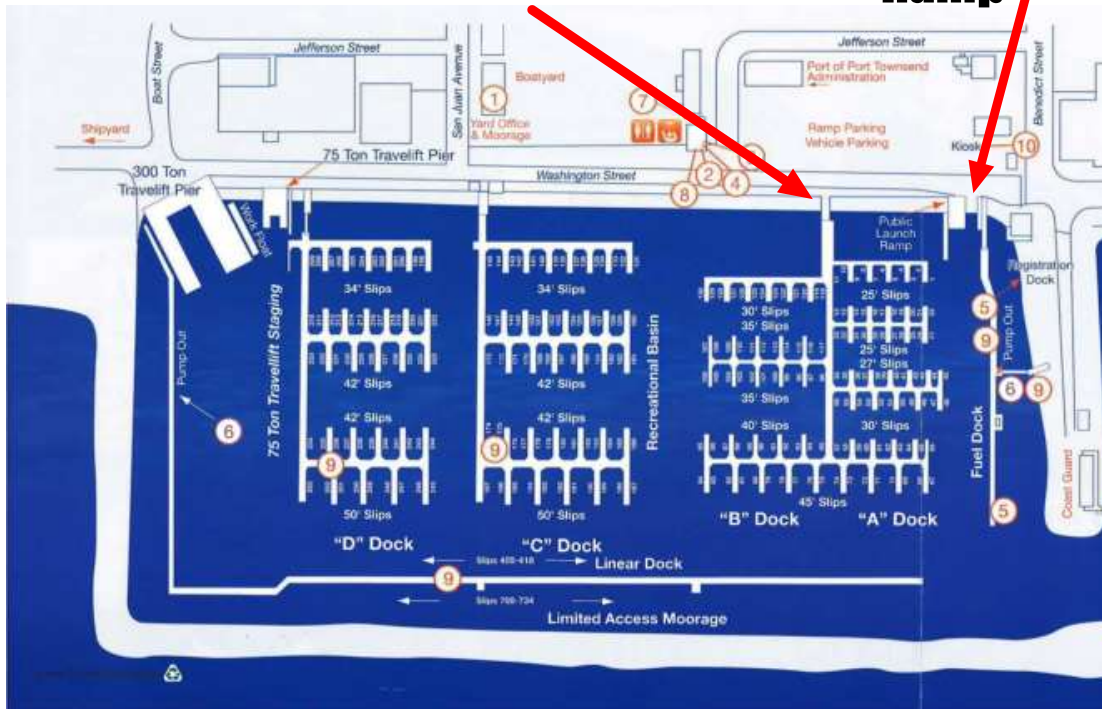
Safety: All boats must meet their class association rules and US Coast Guard safety regulations.
