



**NOTICE OF RACE**

**1. RULES**

The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024, the prescriptions of US SAILING, the current Interscholastic Sailing Association (ISSA) Procedural Rules (PR), this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

**2. SAFETY**

All competitors must wear a USCG approved lifejacket at all times while on the water, except to quickly change clothing.

**3. ELIGIBILITY**

Sailors must be 18 or under to compete.

**4. ENTRY FEE AND REGISTRATION**

There is no entry fee for the Phelps Junior Club Championship.

**5. BOATS**

JYC Club 420's. Boats will be sailed as provided.

**6. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS - Saturday August 20, 2022**

0830-0930 – Check in and Rigging of Boats (John McGowan Sailing Center)

0930 - Competitors Meeting (Mandatory) – (John McGowan Sailing Center)

1000 - First Warning. Racing will continue throughout the day. Races will continue throughout the day, weather permitting.

After the conclusion of racing – Awards (John McGowan Sailing Center)

**7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

Sailing instructions will be available through Regatta Network and at the Competitors meeting Saturday morning. The Official Regatta Notice Board will be located in the John McGowan Sailing Center.

**8. RACING AREA**

All races will be sailed on the waters of the Barnett Reservoir.

**9. SCORING**

While racing will be done as a two-person team, scoring will be by individual entrant. Each entrant will be rotated as skipper and crew through various boats. The order of rotation will be announced at the Competitors meeting. The skipper and crew of a boat will receive the same score for a race. For example, if a Skipper and Crew finish 2<sup>nd</sup>, they will each get 2 points for their individual score. Scoring will be low point scoring per entrant.

#### 10. RACES/COURSES

Courses will follow ISSA PR 7.7 (Rotation of Boats) as further defined in the Sailing Instructions. Based on conditions, the Race Committee will determine the courses.

#### 11. IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL CONTESTANTS

No contestant shall use, either on or off the water, alcoholic beverages (beer, wine, or distilled spirits, each as defined in Chapter 51 of the US Internal Revenue Code and intended for beverage use), or marijuana, cocaine, or any other controlled substance (as defined in 21 US Code 802), the possession of which, by that contestant is unlawful under 21 US Code 841. Infringements of this regulation and/or other discipline expectations occurring during this weekend may be the basis for a hearing under RRS

69.1. The protest committee for such a hearing shall be the regatta chairperson, a member of the ISSA BOD, and the protest committee chairperson. This protest committee shall, at a time and place selected by them, meet to hear said protest, and their decision to impose scoring penalties, or other sanctions they alone deem appropriate, including summary removal from the regatta, shall be final, without appeal.

#### 12. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

#### 13. WAIVER OF LIABILITY

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
