**Notice of Race**

**1. RULES**

The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024, the prescriptions of US SAILING, the current Interscholastic Sailing Association (ISSA) Procedural Rules (PR), this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

**2. SAFETY**

All competitors must wear a USCG approved lifejacket at all times while on the water, except to quickly change clothing.

**3. ELIGIBILITY**

Sailors must be the age of 18 or older to compete.

**4. ENTRY FEE AND REGISTRATION**

There is no entry fee for the Adult Club Championship.

**5. BOATS**

JYC Club 420's. Boats will be sailed single handed as provided.

**6. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS - Saturday August 27, 2022**

0830-0930 – Check in and Rigging of Boats (John McGowan Sailing Center)

0930 - Competitors Meeting (Mandatory) – (John McGowan Sailing Center)

1000 - First Warning. Racing will continue throughout the day. Races will continue throughout the day, weather permitting. Sunday, August 28, 2022, is set as an alternate date in the event that weather is not suitable for sailing on the 27<sup>th</sup>. After the conclusion of racing – Awards (JYC Balcony)

**7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

Sailing instructions will be available through Regatta Network and at the Competitors meeting Saturday morning. The Official Regatta Notice Board will be located in the John McGowan Sailing Center.

**8. RACING AREA**

All races will be sailed on the waters of the Barnett Reservoir.

**9. SCORING**

The Low Point scoring system of RRS A will apply. Sailors will single-hand Club 420's without the aid of a crew member. A handicap system will be in place that may affect the overall score of a sailor. The handicaps will be announced at the Competitor's meeting.

**10. RACES/COURSES**

Courses will follow ISSA PR 7.7 (Rotation of Boats) as further defined in the Sailing Instructions. Based on conditions, the Race Committee will determine the courses.

**11. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS**

By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

**12. WAIVER OF LIABILITY**

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
