

2022 TAYC Open Series Tred Avon Yacht Club Oxford, MD

NOTICE OF RACE As amended to incorporate Amendment #1

1. RULES

- 1.1. The Tred Avon Yacht Club (TAYC) is the Organizing Authority.
- 1.2. The Series will be governed by the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1. The Race Committee intends to post Sailing Instructions on the event website by September 19.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. Any mono-hull at least 18' LOA with a PHRF handicap rating may enter. PHRF handicap ratings will be used to score boats. If a boat does not have a PHRF handicap, the committee will assign one.
- 3.2. Anticipated classes are PHRF Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker.
- 3.3. Boats may register by going to the TAYC website (www.tayc.com/racing) and completing the entry form for the Series.
- 3.4. All Series participants, including skippers and crew, must individually sign and electronically submit the TAYC Regatta Waiver and Release of Liability Form found at www.tayc.com/racing.

4. FEES

4.1. The registration fee for the series is \$40 for TAYC members. Non-members may participate for a fee of \$50.

5. SCHEDULE

6. THE VENUE

6.1. The races will be held on the Tred Avon River.

7. SCORING

- 7.1. All classes will use High Point Scoring, awarding one point for each boat beaten in each race.
 - 7.1.1. Deleted.
 - 7.1.2. Boats with a valid 2022 PHRF of the Chesapeake rating will be scored using that rating. Corrected times will be calculated using PHRF Time-on-Time and Circular Random ratings. If a boat does not have a PHRF handicap, the Organizing Authority will assign one.
 - 7.1.3. Deleted.
 - 7.1.4. A competitor's worst score will be dropped for every four (4) races completed. More than one race may be completed on each race date.

8. AWARDS

- 8.1. Awards will be given as follows: 1 if 3 entries, 2 if 5 entries, 3 if 7 or more entries.
- 8.2. Scores for TAYC member boats with a valid 2022 PHRF of the Chesapeake certificate will be included in season scoring for the TAYC 2022 PHRF Championship Series.

- 8.3. The Series Champion will be recognized at the TAYC Fall Annual Meeting, Sunday, November 11.
- 8.4. Results will be posted at www.tayc.com/racing.
