

NOTICE OF RACE Amended October 6, 2022

1. RULES

- **1.1.** The Tred Avon Yacht Club (TAYC) is the Organizing Authority.
- **1.2.** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the rules of the International Star Class Racing Association (STCR) for the Star fleet.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1. The Sailing Instructions are available on the event website.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- **3.1.** The regatta is open to Star Class boats that comply with STCR 21 and 26.4. The regatta is also open to Shields Class boats.
- **3.2.** Eligible boats are encouraged to register online by going to the TAYC website (www.tayc.com/racing) and completing the entry form for the event by 1500 Friday, Octorber 7th. All registrations must be completed online.
- **3.3.** A Competitor is not entered and will not receive a score until all fees are paid.

4. FEES

4.1. The entry fee for the Star Class is \$40 for US Sailing or CBYRA members, \$45 for non-members to be received no later than 1500 Friday, October 7th. Entry fee includes continental breakfast both days and Sunday post-race hors d'oeuvres. Shields Class entry fee is included in their annual dues.

5. SCHEDULE

1025 Warning signal for first race, subsequent races to follow; no start after 1600 After Racing – Cash Bar

5.4. Sunday, October 9

1025 Warning signal for first race, subsequent races to follow; no start after 1400TBD Post-Race trophy presentation

6. MEASUREMENT

6.1. Boats and sails shall comply with all aspects of the ISCYRA rules.

7. THE VENUE

7.1. Racing will be in the Tred Avon River or the Choptank River S/SW of the Choptank River Light, depending upon weather.

8. SCORING

- **8.1.** RRS Appendix A4, Low Point System, will apply.
- **8.2.** Three races must be completed to constitute the regatta.
- **8.3.** If more than 4 races are completed, a boat's worst score will be excluded from her total score.

9. LAUNCHING

- **9.1.** Boats may launch and haul at TAYC. Trailers must be stored in designated areas clear of the hoist and access lanes. No vehicles may drive on dock.
- **9.2.** Once launched, boats may haul-out after Saturday's racing or remain in the water over night at TAYC's docks.

10. PRIZES

- **10.1.** Prizes fr the Star Class will be awarded as follows: 1, 2 and 3 overall for the weekend.
- 10.2. Special prizes may also be awarded: <u>AB Streeton Trophy</u>: Winning boat after Saturday's racing. <u>North Emory Bartlett Trophy</u>: Winning boat for Sunday's races.
- **10.3.** Prizes will be presented at the TAYC clubhouse following Sunday's racing. Results will be posted at <u>www.tayc.com/racing</u>.
- **10.4.** Prizes for the Shields Class will be awarded when the Fall Series is completed.
