

**NOTICE OF RACE,
TWILIGHT REGATTA CCYC 2022
AUGUST 31ST, SEPTEMBER 7TH, SEPTEMBER 14TH**

Rules. This Regatta will be governed by the RULES as defined by the current *Racing Rules of Sailing* and the Twilight Regatta Sailing Instructions.

Eligibility and Entry.

The Regatta is open to all SDYAC members and all Recognized sail racing Associations. Regatta entry to be made through Regatta Networks. There are three classes. Class 1, Shall consist of Harbor 20's. Class 2, the (Novel fleet), shall consist of: Sport boats, ULDB's, Multi Hulls, Foilers and Class 3 are displacement boats. R/C reserves the right to determine Class.

Schedule.

Three consecutive Wednesday's commencing, August 31st, September 7th and September 14th. Trophy presentation, Dinner and Closing Ceremony Sept. 14th, 19:30, In the Main Ball room, CCYC 30 Grand Caribe, Coronado, CA. Call Club for dinner Reservations.

Courses.

There will be 5 different courses. The course to sail will be determined by wind speed And direction at the start of the race. The days course will be posted at the R/C's Shore side station near the orange marker. That course will be used by all boats. Drones, Video's and tactical monitors will be used to assure course compliance. Your Start time will be available along with courses prior to the race. Warning signal for the Race will be at 17:55. As a courtesy the r/c may make several sounds at 17:54.

All racing will be in Mid San Diego Bay north of the eel grass remediation pond as defined by the cement pilings spanning the bay. Start and finish will be in the CCYC turning basin. Start line is between the orange flag on the R/C boat tethered to the R/C mooring buoy and the basin pin mark displaying an orange flag.

Finishing between the mooring buoy and the shore side R/C station's orange flag.

The basin pin mark must be rounded to port prior to finishing.

Scoring.

Order of finish. DNF, DNS will be scored at one over the number of starters.
